Applications in prescribed form are hereby invited from the bonafide citizens of Bangladesh desiring to participate in the Admission Test for admission in the Undergraduate courses of this University for the session 1997-98. Candidates who have passed H.S.C. examination or its equivalent in 1996 and 1997 are eligible to apply, subject to fulfilment of other conditions.

IN THE FACULTIES OF ENGINEERING, CIVIL ENGINEERING, MECHANICAL ENGINEERING, ELECTRICAL & ELECTRONICS ENGINEERING AND ARCHITECTURE & PLANNING:-

ELIGIBILITY FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION FOR THE ADMISSION TEST

- Candidates must have passed SSC examination of any education board of Bangladesh or its equivalent and obtained at least 50% marks on the average or equivalent grades.
- Candidates must have passed HSC examination of any education board of Bangladesh or its equivalent and obtained at least 60% marks on the average in the subjects of Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry and minimum of 50% marks in each of these three subjects separately or equivalent grades in these subjects.
- A merit list on the basis of the marks of Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry only of the HSC examination or the equivalent grades in these subjects will be prepared. Out of which only the first four thousand and five hundred candidates will be allowed to take part in the Admission Test. All candidates securing the four thousand five hundredth position having equal marks, will also be allowed to take part in the Admission Test.

SUBJECTS OF ADMISSION TEST FOR 4-YEAR COURSE IN ENGINEERING DEPARTMENTS, URBAN & REGIONAL PLANNING DEPARTMENT AND 5-YEAR COURSE IN ARCHITECTURE DEPARTMENT:-

Examination shall be taken based on the course curriculae of Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry and English (Functional including Comprehension) of the Boards of Intermediate and Secondary Education Bangladesh for the year 1997. Candidates seeking admission for Architecture Department will have to appear in the Free Hand Drawing Test additionally.

There will be one admission test for different departments under the five faculties in the following two groups ('Ka') and ('Kha')

('Ka') Engineering Departments and Urban & Regional Planning Department and

('Kha') Architecture Department

Admission tests under each group will be taken out of total 600 marks. Subjects — and subjectwise distribution of marks are shown in the table below:

Candidates seeking admission in both the groups ('Ka') and ('Kha'), shall sit for examination of all the subjects [Module A — Chemistry, Module B — Mathematics, Physics and English (Functional including Comprehension) and Module C — Free Hand Drawing].

NUMBER OF SEATS:

The total number of seats in B.Sc. Engineering, Bachelor of Urban & Regional Planning and B. Arch courses under the five faculties is 725, of which 3 seats in Engineering and 1 seat in Architecture are reserved for the candidates from Chittagong Hill Tracts and other Tribal areas of Bangladesh.

FOR ALL FACULTIES

Candidates from Tribal areas must submit certificates from the principal of the college from which they passed HSC examination or the Chairman of local Pourashava/Zilla Parishad or Union Parishad and must indicate in the application form that they belong to Tribal area. Candidates for these reserved seats must also fulfil the minimum qualification requirements for the Test. There will be no separate admission test for the reserved seats for tribal students.

PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS (FOR ALL FACULTIES):

Application form and prospectus mentioning admission test procedures for each group may be obtained directly from the Registrar's office on cash payment of the required fees mentioned below or by sending Pay Order/Bank Draft of the required fees in favour of Bangladesh University of Engineering & Technology (drawn on Sonali Bank in any branch in Dhaka City) along with a 255x115 mm or 10 x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ inch SELF ADDRESSED envelope bearing postage stamps of Tk. 10/- (Taka ten) only.

Steps to reduce number of road accidents stressed

Speakers at a workshop yesterday emphasised the need for taking effective measures to reduce road accidents in Bangladesh and said overloaded and badly loaded heavy vehicles contributing to the very high rate of accident in the country. reports BSS.

They said one accident in three involves a truck while in the thirty months till July 1997 a total of 1709 accidents were reported out of which, trucks were involved in 568 road accidents.

Participating at a workshop on the prevention of truck overloading at a local hotel here, they said these accidents resulted in over 15,000 casualties
