M Akhter Ali, a retired Secretary of the government, died of heart attack Monday night. He was 57, reports UNB.

He left behind his wife, two sons, a daughter, and a host of relatives, friends and admirers.

He was buried at the Banani graveyard after *namaz-e-janaza* at Gulshan Central Jame Mosque after *Zohr* prayers yesterday.

Qulhwani of Akhter Ali will be held on Friday at his residence at Gulshan after *Aср* prayers.

Akhter Ali joined the then Pakistan Civil Service in 1965. He served as the Principal Secretary-in-charge to the President in 1991.

Before his retirement as Industry Secretary, he served as Agriculture and Jute Secretary.

Akhter Ali was the elder brother of Agriculture Secretary A M M Shawkat Ali.

In a message of condolence, President Shahabuddin Ahmed recalled the sincere and dedicated services of M Akhter Ali to the nation throughout his service career.

The President visited the residence of M Akhter Ali yesterday.

The president stayed there for some time and consoled the members of the bereaved family.


Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina also condoled the death of former Industry Secretary M Akhter Ali.

Two commit suicide

Two persons including a girl allegedly committed suicide in the city yesterday, police said.

Mariful Islam, 27, son of Abdul Jabbar of Lalpur, Natore, was an employee of a garment factory, Cotton Line, BD Ltd, at Mirpur.

He committed suicide by hanging from the beam of his house at Pallabi at around 1 pm, police said.

His body was sent to Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) for autopsy. An unnatural death case was filed with Pallabi Thana.

In another incident a 17-year-old girl Dipika committed suicide by hanging from ceiling fan at her 60, Moddhyia (Central) Bashabo residence at any time between 8:30 am to 1:15 pm.

Dipika, daughter of one Hajaril Biswas was a first year HSC student of Bashabo High School and College. Her body was sent to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital. An unnatural death case was filed with Sabujbag Thana.

JATI yet to shift to new premises

The Judicial Administration Training Institute (JATI) has suspended its training activities for an uncertain period since January 1 as the authorities concerned had asked the institute to shift its establishment from the present location at the old High Court building, reports BSS.

The old High Court building is being vacated to set up more court rooms for judges, said sources in the Ministry of Works.

Meanwhile, the government has allotted two floors of the old Meteorological Office building for the JATI. The building at Sher-e-Bangla Nagar, will need to undergo renovation work worth Tk 1.27 crore, estimated the PWD. The amount, however, is yet to be sanctioned by the Finance Ministry, sources said.

When the institute was preparing to shift, the government ordered the transfer of its founder director Iktedar Ahmed, said sources in the Law Ministry.

Since its establishment in early 1997, the JATI has organised five training courses involving 25 assistant judges and 140 subordinate judges.




