THE LEGENDARY LINEAGE


The family of the sarod maestro, Ustad Amjad Ali Khan, is traced back to Mohammad Hashmi Khan Bangash, who migrated to India from Afghanistan, bringing the plucked instrument called rabab. The fifth generation was represented by ustad Hafiz Ali Khan, who died in 1972. His youngest son, ustad Amjad Ali Khan (born 1945), brought the family instrument to a world-wide audience, through concerts and recordings, and is firmly established as one of India's most distinguished and successful artists. Bringing three generations of the same family, united by the same music and instrument, together on a single recording is a special achievement, and seems to have been the inspiration of Ustad Amjad Ali Khan's wife, Subhalakshmi, an artist in her own right and sustainer of the family and its heritage. 2 CDs Price: Tk 1200/=







THE World of Muslim Women in Colonial Bengal Author: Sonia Nishat Amin

Publisher: Brill This highly interesting book studies the cultural context of modemisation of middle-class Muslim women in late 19th and 20th century Bengal. Its frames of reference are the Bengal 'Awakening', the Reform Movements -Brahmo/Hindu and Muslim - and the Women's Question as articulated in material and ideological terms throughout the period. Tracing the emergence of the modern Muslim gentlewomen, the bhadramahild, starting in 1876 when Nawab Faizunnesa Chaudhurani published her first book and ending with the foundation in 1939 of The Lady Brabourne College, the book gives an excellent analysis of the rise of a Muslim woman's public sphere and broadens our knowledge of Bengali social history in the colonial period. 

Sri Aurobindo (1872-1950), a pioneer of India's freedom movement, poet, seer and the exponent of Integral Yoga, visualises the possibility of humanity fulfilling its evolutionary destiny through a process of transformation. His remarkable works like The Life Divine. The Synthesis of Yoga, The Human Cycle and The ideal of Human Unity present an analysis of history, both spiritual and chronological, and trace the process of the unfoldment of this gnostic mystery, while his epic, Savitri, discovers to us the manifold occult realities beneath and above the life as we know it.



Nationalism WITHOUT A NATION in India Author: G. Aloysius

This is a sociological interpretation of modern indian history. It is also a hard-hitting critique of nationalist historiography as well as the Indian national movement. Aloysius evaluates anti-caste, non-Brahmin and other socio-religious movements in a new light and seeks to place them within mainstream history. He sees the national movement in the context of a multiplicity of political awakenings which took place during the colonial period. His conclusion is that internal cleavages within Indian society, rather than the obvious external contradiction be tween Indians and British, were responsible for the outcome of the nationalist movement and the failure of the nation to emerge.
