Position: Social Scientist Background: Bangladesh has an active portfolio of projects in social and economic sectors with substantive participatory components. To translate its commitment to increase stakeholder involvement in projects, the Dhaka Office plans to strengthen its capacity in the field of social assessment. The objective is to build a field level capacity to facilitate project preparation with stakeholder participation, monitor and supervise the existing projects for a greater social impact and to take a proactive role in dealing directly with many social and institutional issues. There is also a need to interact closely with the rich NGO community in Bangladesh.

Tasks: The social scientist will be a member of the Dhaka-based Social Team. The selected person would inter alia be responsible for technical support to the Dhaka Office for: (i) social assessments, stakeholder and gender analysis in Project Preparation and implementation; (ii) social analysis and participation as inputs in the preparation of Country Assistance Strategy and sectoral work; (iii) inputs related to issues of minorities, women and children; (iv) resettlement issues in collaboration with the specialist in the infrastructure and agriculture sectors; and (v) initiating and managing studies undertaken by local and international consultants in the area of social development

Qualification and Experience: Candidates should have a master degree in social sciences, with demonstrated experience in conducting and managing social assessment, stakeholder participation and gender analysis. At least, seven years work experience in initiating and managing interdisciplinary research on development issues; regional or cross regional experience will be a plus. In addition, the following qualifications are required: (i) analytical and conceptual skills, particularly relating to social, economic and statistical dimensions of problems in various sectors; (ii) excellent writing and communication skills; (iii) proven ability to work effectively as a member of an inter-disciplinary team; (iv) excellent field-level skills and proven ability to work effectively with local counterparts and consultants; and (v) computer literacy.

The incumbent will be expected to travel extensively within and outside of Bangladesh, and must be willing to work under challenging circumstances. The appointment will be initially for a year with the expectation of extension if performance is fully satisfactory. The need for this position is seen as long term.
