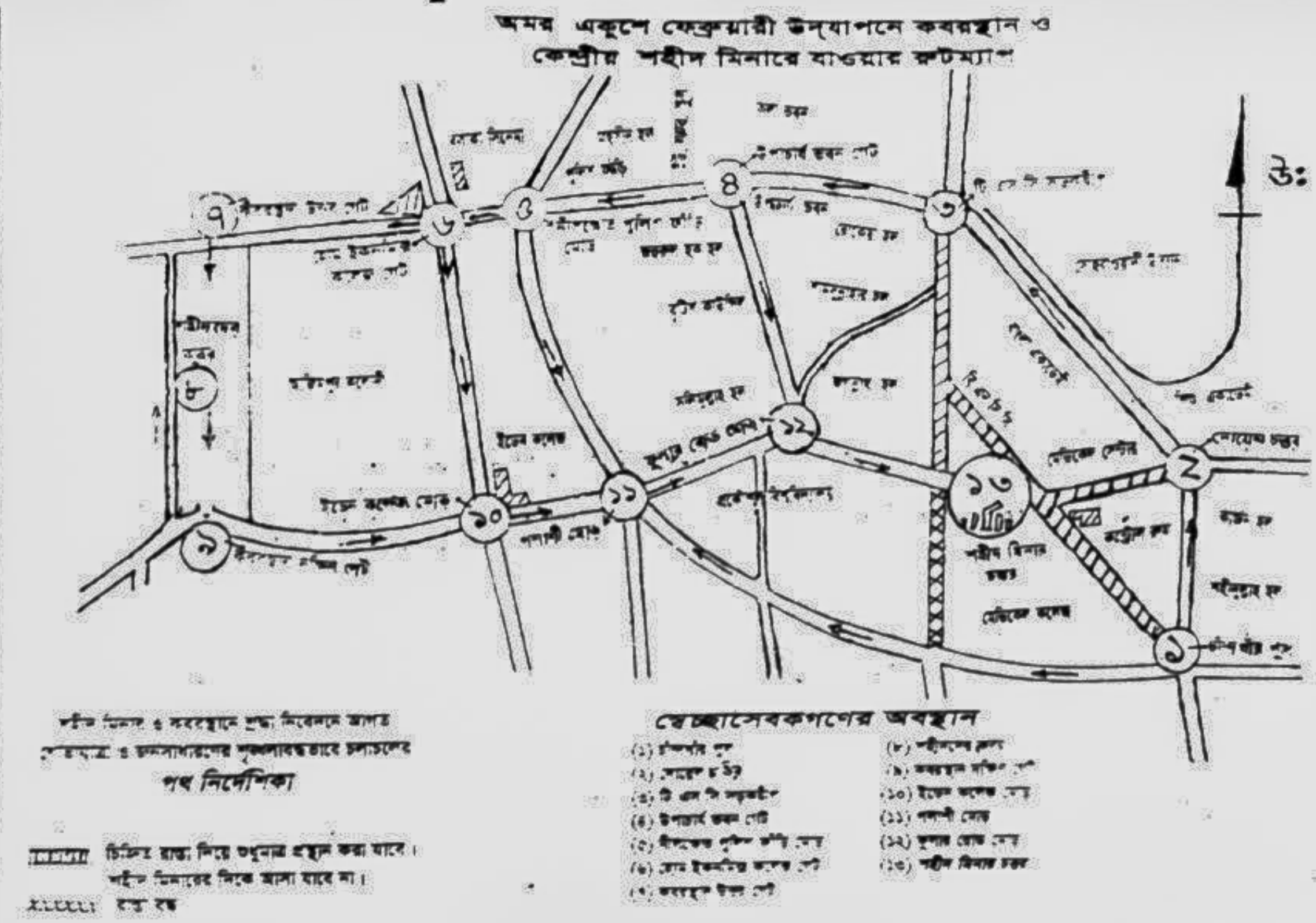

Programmes on Bangabandhu's birthday
The 78th birth anniversary of Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman will be observed on March 17 in a befitting manner, reports BSS.
An inter-ministerial meeting at the Ministry of Cultural Affairs with State Minister for Youth, Sports and Cultural Affairs Obaidul Quader in the chair yesterday decided to observe the birth anniversary of the architect of Bangladesh through elaborate programmes.
Ministry of Cultural Affairs will hold the main day-long programme at Tungipara, the birth place of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman. The programme includes prayers at Bangabandhu's mazar, milad mahfil, ziarat, shishu kishore shamabesh, (children's gathering), discussions and cultural function.
National Book Centre will also arrange mobile book fair at Tungipara.
Bangladesh Shilpakala Academy, Bangla Academy, National Museum, Nazrul Institute, National Book Centre, Islamic Foundation and Bangladesh Shishu Academy will jointly organise a discussion and cultural function in the capital.
National dailies will publish supplements while Bangladesh Betar and Bangladesh Television will broadcast special programmes marking the event.
Besides the divisional, district and thana headquarters will observe the day through different programmes.

Minister stresses use of merit, wisdom as a resource
Minister of State for Planning, Science and Technology Dr Mohiuddin Khan Alamgir said here yesterday that the government has taken steps to establish a "knowledge-based" society in the country, reports BSS.
"We want to portray the potentialities of the nation to the world community by using our merit and wisdom as a resource," the minister said while speaking as the chief guest at the certificate-awarding ceremony of a training course at the Atomic Energy Centre in the city.
Bangladesh Atomic Energy Commission (BAEC) and International Atomic Energy Agency (IAEA) jointly organised the two-week long national training course on "upgradation of nuclear medical equipment".
Eminent scientist and chairman of BAEC Dr M A Wazed Miah presided over the function. It was also addressed, among others, by Fazlur Rahman, Secretary, Ministry of Science and Technology, Dr Sanaullah, Convenor, training course organising committee, Dr Jahangir Alam, Principal Scientific Officer, BAEC, and two IAEA experts Dr Alentin Fidler and engineer Milan Prepadnik.
A total of 37 physicians and scientists from different nuclear medicine centres, institute of nuclear medicine, institute of electronics, electronics division of atomic energy centre, Dhaka, and two private organisations took part in the training course to get the best out of the present situation of the equipment in the country.
The minister said although Bangladesh is handicapped by lack of resources, it has a huge manpower waiting for the right moment to be triggered through timely support. This training course will help a lot in this regard, he added.
He said BAEC is enriched with bright, talented and energetic scientists of whom some have already proved their worth abroad. If other scientists and doctors of the country could be provided with proper training about latest information, technology and equipment, it would not be an exception inside developing Bangladesh, he opined.
Dr Alamgir said nuclear medicine is not new in the country but the upgradation of nuclear equipment is certainly new. He said this upgradation technique by computer interfacing was bound to have a good social and economic impact.
He said Bangladesh scientists should enrich their knowledge by sharing modern technologies with the already developed countries.

Two allegedly commit suicide in city

A teenage girl and a woman allegedly committed suicide in the city yesterday morning.
Police said Hasi, 14, daughter of Akbar Mollah, allegedly committed suicide by hanging herself from the hook of a ceiling fan inside her house at Aziz Mohallah under Mohammadpur thana at about 10 am.
Hasi had been suffering from abdominal pain for quite a long time.
She might have killed herself for not being able to tolerate such pain, police suspected.
Police yet to send the body to DMCH for autopsy.
An unnatural death case has been filed with Mohammadpur thana.
In another incident, Prapajati Mandal, 24, daughter of Masal Mandal, allegedly killed herself by hanging from a beam with a rope in her residence at South Kunipara under Tejgaon thana at about 4:30 am.
The real reason behind the alleged suicide could not be ascertained immediately.
The body was sent to the DMCH morgue for autopsy.
An unnatural case was lodged with Tejgaon thana.
