The sources quoted the BNP side as saying that on the issue of street rallies they needed some achievement for a 'minimum sense of victory' in the dialogue.


When the talks resume at 7 this evening, negotiators of both the parties are expected to bargain further on the still unresolved issues, the street rallies in particular.

From Page 1 time of the settlement. But later, Abul Khair without paying the money applied to the court for extension of time. Artha Rin Adalat by an order on May 19, 1997, extended the time for payment up to September 16, 1997. Litu, at this stage, presented fresh cheques. He also applied to Al-Baraka Bank not to present the cheques until October 25, 1997.

Al-Baraka presented the cheques for collection on October 26, 1997 and the cheques bounced. When the bank threatened 'bring criminal prosecutica against Abul Khair, he went to the Fourth Artha Rin Adalat and filed a suit in which he prayed for an injunction against the bank for restraining the bank from taking any criminal proceedings.

Subsequently, he got the injunction. On appeal by Al-Baraka Bank, a High Court division bench comprising Justice Mahmudul Amin Chowdhury and Justice Gour Gopal Saha by a judgement yesterday set aside the order of injunction granted by the Fourth Artha Rin Adalat and allowed the appeal of the bank.

The HC observed, among other things, that prima facie plaintiff (Abul Khair) is not true to his words and did not come with clean hands.

The HC further held that Abul Khair himself was party to the 'solenama' in the earlier suit by which his liability came down from Tk 137 crore to only Tk 34 crore and yet tried to avoid that 'solenama' decree. He did not file a complaint or appeal against that decree.

As such, the present suit by Abul Khair is not maintainable and he is not entitled to injunction as prayed for, the court observed.

Barrister Syed Ishtiaq Ahmed, Dr. M Zahir and Advocate Sayed Shahid Hossain appeared for Al-Baraka Bank. Barrister Rafiqui Huq appeared for Abul Khair.


