DURBAN, Mar 1: Leg-spinner Mushtaq Ahmed bowled Pakistan to a strong position in the second cricket Test against South

Africa on Sunday, reports AP.

Mushtaq took 6-66 in 35 unchanged overs to leave South Africa struggling on 186 for eight after being set 255 runs to

Earlier, Pakistan resuming the second innings on 222 for eight was bowled out for 226, the innings lasting just eight balls in nine minutes.

The South African second innings crumbled as fast as the Kingsmead pitch and only a stubborn ninth wicket stand has stopped Pakistan of wrapping up the Test inside four

Wicketkeeper Mark Boucher and No. 10 Fanie de Villiers have staged a minor recovery rescuing the side from a precariously placed 133 for eight.

The pair have put on 53 runs in 59 minutes and have benefited from two dropped catches and a half chance.

Both batsmen were dropped in successive overs as Pakistan let the home side off the hook. Bad light stopped play seven overs short when the two umpires Mervyn Kitchen and Dave

The country's ace swimmer of yesteryears, Brojen Das, is fighting for his life at the Tata Memorial Hospital in Calcutta. Brojen Das (67), who is suffering from cancer, is in intensive care at the famous Indian hospital. He was taken from Dhaka to Calcutta a few days back after his condition deteriorated.

The first natant of the subcontinent to cross the English Channel way back in 1964, Brojen Das has requested the ministry of Youth and Sports for financial support to bear the cost of his treatment.

Obaidul Quader, the minister for Youth and Sports, has already made a grant of taka one lakh towards his treatment. But Ratna Das, wife of the celebrated son of the soil, has in a letter to the sports supremo requested for a sum of take five lakh for Brojen's treatment.

In his luminous career Brojen Das led the all-Pakistan swimming team in 1964. He was the general secretary of the Bangladesh Swimming Federation (BSF) from 1972-1976. He was a vice-president from 1976-

A stubborn man, Brojen Das, had earlier gone through a byepass surgery in the United States in 1993. Born in Munshiganj, Brojen Das earned many a laurel for his country. He has a son and a daughter. His family, however, is now settled

OUAGADOUGOU. Mar 1 (Reuters/ AP): Two goals in the opening 13 minutes ensured Egypt won a fourth African Na

tions' Cup in Saturday's final against World Cup qualifiers South Africa, reports Reuters. Ahmed Hassan struck after

just five minutes and Tarek Mostafa scored eight minutes later to give Egypt a 2-0 victory over the defending champions. But the two goals effectively killed the tournament's showpiece, with Egypt's defence competently holding out against an impotent South Africa attack

in searing heat. Egypt last won the trophy 12 years ago, but their victory on Saturday saw them equal Ghana's record of four tournament triumphs.

The win was a record achievement for 60-year-old coach Mahmoud Al-Gohari. who become the first man to win the championship as both a player and coach.

He was in Egypt's wining team in 1959, when he ended as the tournament's leading

Clutching the cup, team captain Hossam Hassan stepped off the plane and on to a red carpet where Mubarak kissed him and the rest of the team in scenes broadcast live on state television.


