Price index falls further

The All Share Price Index of the Dhaka Stock Exchange again declined on Wednesday as the losers outnumbered the gainers, reports UNB. The price indicator fell by 1.24 points or 0.18 per cent to 671.00 points from Tuesday's 672.24 points. Some 360,082 shares and debentures valued at Tk 3.48 crore were traded as against 417,446 shares valued at Tk 4.50 crore on the previous day. Shares of some 131 listed securities were transacted, of which 56 gained, 78 incurred loss and one remained unchanged. Shine Pukur Holdings Ltd (20.250), Chic Tex Ltd (36.000), Beximco Pharma (56.250) and Rose Heaven Ball Pen Ltd (48,500) were among the volume leaders. Major gainers of the day

were Beximco Denims (+Tk 125.00), Beximco Textiles (+Tk 90.00) and Banglades Lamps (+Tk 11.78).

United Leasing Company (-Tk 11.55), Apex Foods (-Tk 19.19), Bangladesh Leaf Tobacco (-Tk 23.50) and Usmania Glass Sheet Factory (-Tk 20.63) were among the major losers.
