

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday emphasised on further improving the standard of journalism in the country and maintaining objectivity and accuracy in reporting news, reports UNB.

"Prime objective of journalism should be people's welfare to make it more acceptable to masses," she said while exchanging views with the leaders of Dhaka Reporters' Unity (DRU) at her office in the after-

Hasina said the standard of reporting should be raised further to meet the open challenge of the fast changing world.

She said that in the face of increasing challenges under the open market concept, the news reporting should be more broadbased to make it more acceptable to the people. The reporters, she added.

journalists can guide the nation

in solving the national problems and also depict the reasons behind the exploitation and repression of the downtrodden

Mentioning various steps of the government, she said the objective of her government is to ensure a better life for the people and their economic emancipation.

"We'll have to bring changes in our system to survive by facing the challenges of the open market economy ... we'll have to be self-reliant and improve our condition.

Alleviation of poverty is imperative for the economic development, she said adding that the government has laid utmost emphasis on removing illiteracy for achieving economic progress

#### Professionals call on President

A nine-member delegation of various professional groups, led by former Adviser Dr M A Majed, called on President Shahabuddin Ahmed at Banga-

bhaban yesterday, reports UNB.
The members of delegation discussed with President the recently signed CHT Peace Agreement and pointed out that certain provisions of the agree-ment are not in consonance with the national interest as well as the Constitution of Bangladesh.

They said the agreement will pave the way for secessionist tendencies in other parts of the country and added that the proposed regional council for the Hill Tracts will directly hit the unitary character of the constitution.

Referring to the Supreme Court Judgement on the 8th Amendment of the Constitution, they said approval of the regional council for making any law is contrary to the constitution as it will curtail the sovereign authority of the par-

The members of the delegation also observed that the proposed treatment to the nontribal people who constitute almost half of the population there will violate equality provision of the fundamental

President said the agreement between the government and the tribal leaders was a necessity, but it requires to be made into law. When draft bill on the agreement will be placed in Parliament, it should be discussed threadbare, he added.

The president hoped that the required law will be made on the basis of consensus among the members of parliament belonging to different parties.

The members of the delegation included Abu Hena, MP Prof Emajuddin Ahmed, agriculturist SA Samad, columnist Sadeq Khan, Engineer LK Siddiqui, Prof Mahbubullah, Prof Mahumdul Amin and Prof Yusuf Haider.




