# Tourist spots yet to be developed in N-region

NATORE, Mar 10:Bangladesh Parjatan Corporation (BPC) has neither tried to create new tourist spots nor it has given due attention to the development of the existing places of historical interest in the northern part of the country includ-

ing Natore, reports UNB. The experts said that the government could earn a huge revenue income from this sector if the region was included in its proposed 10-year comprehensive development programme of BPC.

It is learnt that the proposed comprehensive plan involves a total of Tk 389 crore for implementation of a large number of schemes including 71 broadbased ones.

The schemes include development of transport system increasing of recreational facilities exploration of markets. BPĆ an organised national

body for tourist development, since its inception in 1973, has devoted most of its time and energy to some of the well known tourist spots like Cox's Bazar, Rangamati and Dhaka but it did not pay heed to the panoramic

spots of Rani Bhabani's Palace and its ground, Chowgram King's palace at Shingra thana. Dayarampur King's Palace under Lalpur thana and Natore Uttara Gonobhaban of the district, Puthia Rajbari of Rajshahi district, historical "Sona Majid" at Chapainawab-gonj, Paharpur Bouddha Bihar

KURIGRAM, Mar 10: A fierce clash between two rival groups of people at Boltarpar village in Ulipur thana over land dispute on Tuesday left a man killed, reports UNB.

The deceased was identified as Enamul, son of Akbar Ali. According to police, the two groups, led by Akbar Ali and his brother Joynab Ali, had an altercation that led to the bloody clash, leaving Enamul criti-

cally injured. He was rushed to Sadar Hospital where he succumbed to his injuries at noon.

draw attention of the authority. Experts said, motel could be built and facilities like boats and other transports could be made available to these beauty spots of these districts to attract the tourists.

Moreover, the services of guides and centres should be extended to earn additional crores of taka every year.
