Housewife burnt to death

NARAYANGANJ, Mar 11: A husband allegedly burnt his wife alive following a family feud on Saturday evening at Nayaati Muktingar area of Siddhirganj thana, reports UNB. Police said Ashrafur Rahman Malibub killed his wife Hossain Ara setting fire after covering her with a quilt and pouring kerosene on her body. The cruel husband went into hiding after the incident. A case was filed with the police by the father of the victim.

14 injured in Netrakona bus accident

NETRAKONA, Mar 11: About 14 persons including five women and four children were injured following a bus accident on Sunday near Nasibpur about 15 kms south-east of here on Netrakona-Madan road, reports BSS. Police said the accident occurred when a Netrakona-bound speeding passenger bus from Madan thana skidded off the road and fell into a roadside farm land as the driver of the bus lost control over the steering.

The Sardar Dairy Farm and Poultry Complex at Farjikanda in Bandar thana caught fire at around 10:45 pm and was burnt to ashes, witnesses said.

Cotton farming falls short of target in Jessore

JESSORE, Mar 11: Cotton cultivation has failed to achieve the target in Jessore zone during the current season.

According to local office of Cotton Development Board, cotton has been cultivated on 7,892 hectares land while the target was 11 thousand hectares of land. A total of 7900 metric tons of cotton seeds out of this cultivation is expected this season, according to local office.

Jessore zone is divided into 18 units comprising Monirampur, Jhapa, Rajganj Khajura, Kotwali, Keshabpur, Hassanpur, Jhinkergacha, Sharsha, Chowgacha and Ulashi in Jessore Patkelghata, Tala, Kolaroa, Deara in Satkhira and Barobazar in Jhenidah districts. It was learnt, though the tar-

get for cotton cultivation has not been achieved in current season, yet then, if the production is achieved as expected, it will be worth Taka 21 crores, one crore more than that of last year.

Giving reasons for failure to achieve the target of cultivation the office informed, adverse climatic condition, transfer of responsibility to NGO for cotton cultivation, pilferage of cotton and abnormal price hike of fertiliser, pesticides and scarcity of quality seeds were behind bad output.

Giving districtwide cotton cultivation, the source said in Jessore district, cotton has been cultivated on 6790 hectares in Satkhira on 682 hectares and in Jhenidah district on 420 hectares of land have been

brought under the cultivation programme. Massive programme for cultivation of cotton has been taken up in Jogodishpur Cotton Seed Multiplications Farm and Research Centre of Chowgacha thana in the district.

Improved variety of cotton has been cultivated on a total of 100 acres of land while another 10 acres have been selected to cultivate cotton for research purpose in this season.

Besides, BRAC, a NGO has taken extensive programme for cotton cultivation in different project areas in Monirampur thana of the district.
