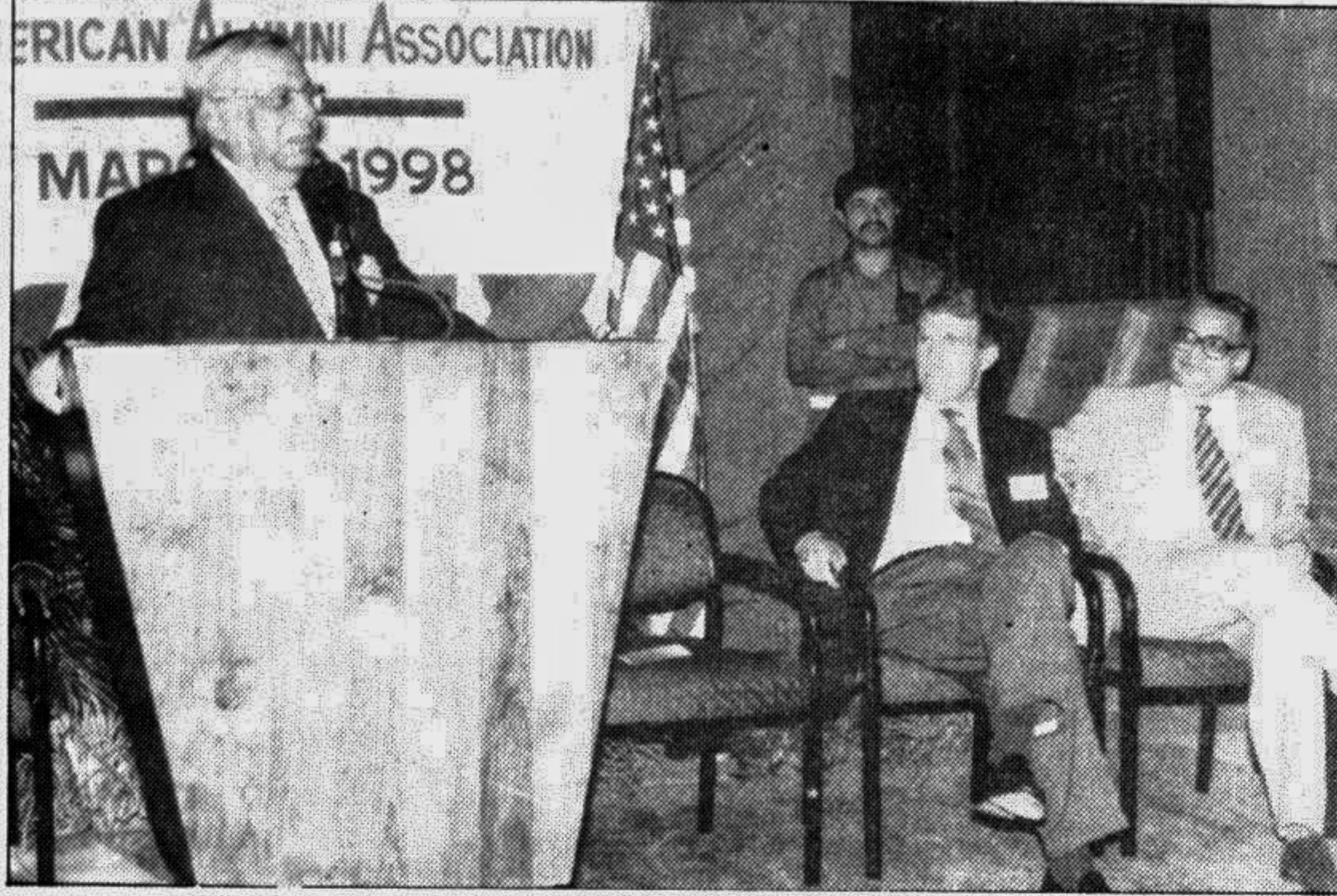

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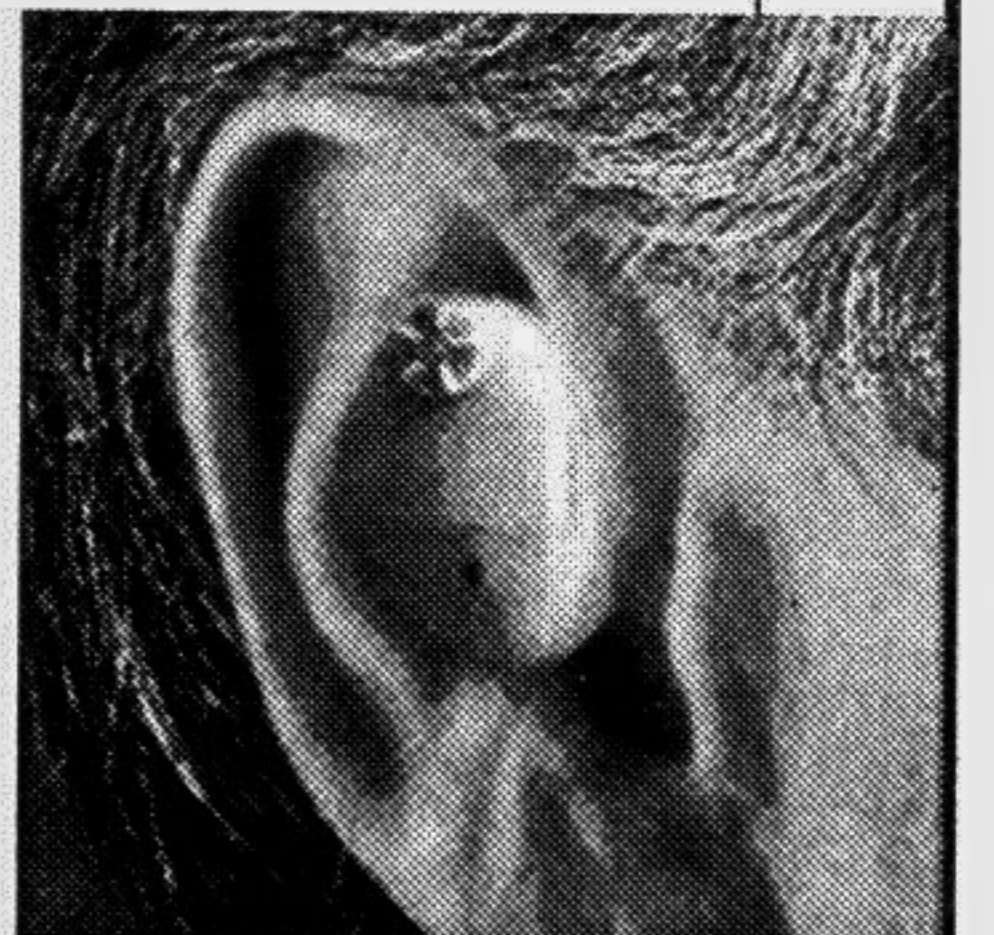

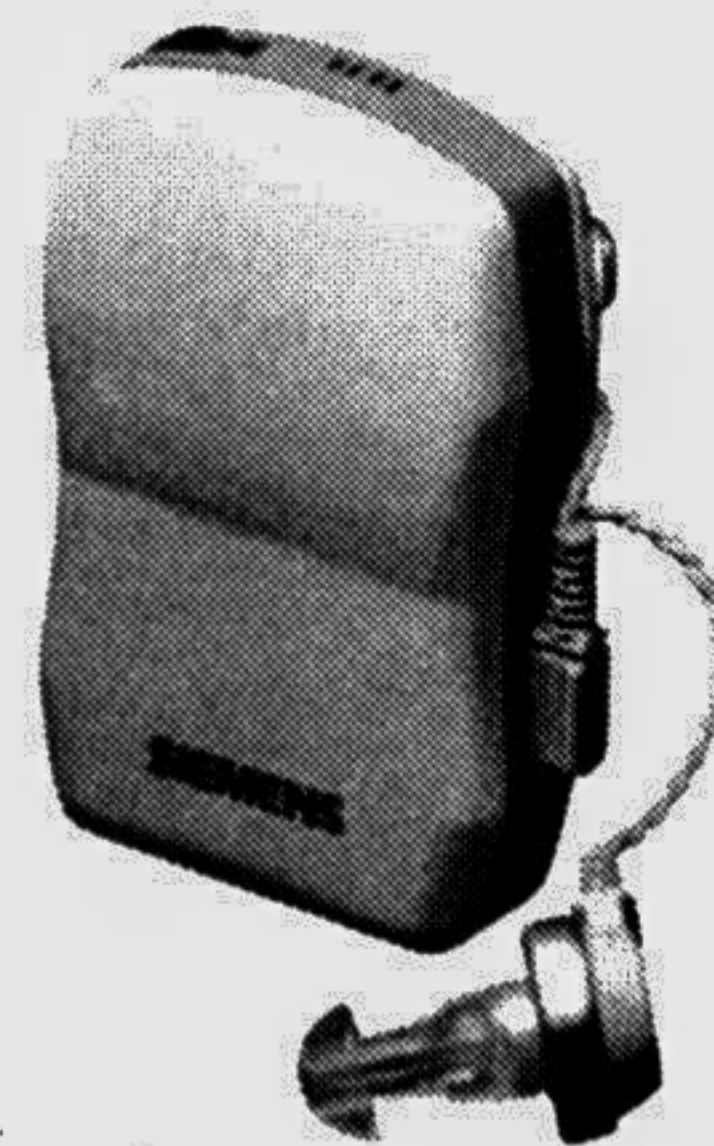

Applications are invited from Bangladesh nationals to the following top level management positions of UCEP-Bangladesh, a national NGO engaged in human resources development by providing non-formal education, vocational skills training and employment support services to children and youth among the urban poor in Bangladesh.

1. Deputy Director (Corporate Affairs)

Accountable to the Chief Executive, be a dynamic leader having high academic qualification, minimum Master's level preferably in Business Administration (MBA); at least five years' experience at higher management level in a reputed developmental organization including NGO with proven abilities in personnel management, well conversant with human resources development (HRD) strategies to ensure high level of competencies of staff, and be sufficiently experienced in providing logistics and general administrative services in support of several Social Services delivery components of big complex organization; should be able to provide professional guidance and supervision over MIS, Research, Project Planning (including strategic development planning), Public Relations; maintain liaison with top level personnel at public and private organizations for networking and partnership promotion; be capable of supervising and co-ordinating a number of Managers/Chiefs responsible for various components. The overall responsibility of looking after the administrative affairs of the organization will include ensuring implementation of physical development plan, maintenance of properties and assets. The incumbent has to be able to develop a congenial staff environment and a sound overall corporate health of the organization with sufficient capability to assist in the development of the organization in the direction demanded by the environment and its changes. Must have excellent command over spoken and written English, excellent communication skill in English and Bangla and be able to independently prepare professional papers/reports. Must have commitment to NGO efforts and working with the poor.

2. Deputy Director (Programmes)

Accountable to the Chief Executive, be a dynamic leader having excellent academic background, at least Graduate in Engineering/Master's level in the field of Management/Business Administration/ Education/Social Science with a thorough understanding of vocational skills training and non-formal education activities for poor children/youth, and familiarity with the national policy and programmes for human resources development in Bangladesh. Experience or familiarity with running business/ industrial enterprise will carry additional weight. Must have at least five years work experience at a senior executive/managerial level in large industry/business organizations/ educational/vocational training institutions; proven ability to co-ordinate, guide and supervise a number of integrated components each headed by a Manager; proven ability to plan, monitor, control and evaluate activities in both physical and financial terms; be able to interact and maintain liaison with top level public and private sector officials; must possess excellent human relations skills, ability to write professional reports on programmes independently, excellent command over spoken and written English, commitment to NGO efforts, proven initiative and innovative efforts for achieving organizational goals including financial sustainability, demonstrated habit of sharing heavy workloads. Engineering/ industrial background combined with management/business administration will get preference.

Both the positions (Dhaka based) are highly demanding; require high level of commitment.
