# Alleged killers of housewife yet to be nabbed

JHENIDAH, Mar 30: Police could not arrest alleged killers of Kazoli who had allegedly been killed by the members of her husband's house on March 9, according to family sources.

Kazoli, 20, daughter of a day labourer of village Kakiladri under Mohepur thana was married to Abdur Razzak at village Niamatpur under Kaliganj thana about 5 years back. In the meantime Kazoli alias Mukto became mother of a child. But since marriage Razzak used to force her to bring down from her father's house. It was not possible on the part of Kazoli's father to offer dowry.

Following this the family members of Razzak used to abuse and torture her frequently.

On March 9 last, Razzak, his father and mother began to torture Kazoli and she received severe injury on her head. Then the dishonest husband and his family members spread poison in her mouth and declared that Kazoli took poison to commit suicide. Kazoli was rushed to Mohepur thana health complex in a critical condition and succumbed to her injuries in the evening.

An influential group convinced police there she committed suicide and this buried the body the next day on March 10. Rajab Ali, father of dead Kazoli informed the matter to Jhenidah women oppression resistance committee. But the alleged killers have been threatening Razab Ali, not to move further, Razab Ali said.

## 3 murderers get life-term RI

SHERPUR, Mar 30: A court here has sentenced three people to life-term rigorous imprisonment (RI) for killing a man in 1991, court sources said, reports UNB.

Jalal, Moslem and Momtaj Ali were also fined Tk 2,000 each, in default, to suffer six months more RI, according to the judgement delivered by District and Sessions Judge M Ismail Mia on March 18.

Four other accused — Hame-sha Khatun, Abdul Huq, Sham-sul and Abdul Berek — were acquitted.

According to the prosecution, the convicted picked up Kasem, son of late Matizuddin, from his house of Tantar village in Nalitabari thana on December 27, 1991 and killed him. After filing a case by the victim's uncle with Nalitabari thana police chargesheeted against the seven.

## Work of bridges over Sandhya, Doarika to begin soon

BARISAL, Mar 30: Construction work of two bridges over the river Sandhya at Shikarpur and Doarika on Barisal-Faridpur highway are expected to be started from this financial year.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina approved the project in the Executive Committee of National Economic Council (ECNEC) meeting along with other project on Sunday. These two bridges will be of 242.50 metres and 388 metres long at Shikarpur and at Doarika ferries under Babuganj thana of Barisal. Both the bridges will be of 10 metres wide each. Both the bridges will be constructed with the expenditure of Taka 117.76 crore, of which Kuwait government (RPA) will provide Tk 19.83 crore. The rest Tk 21.93 crore will be provided by the Bangladesh government.

Roads and Highways (R&H) department will implement the project within 1999-2000 financial year, it has been learnt.

Meanwhile, on Friday last proposed places of the bridges at Shikarpur and Doarika have already been visited by a Kuwaiti expert team which included an engineer and an economist.

## Faulty planning blamed for ineffectiveness of "Polder-1"

NAOGAON, Mar 30: The Tk 104 crore flood protection project "Polder-1" remains ineffective since its completion in June '96, reports UNB.

Local leaders and experts blame faulty planning for the present situation.

The project was implemented with the objective of protecting about 40 sq km of cultivable land from seasonal flooding. But a big gap of 4.33 km in the embankment between Naogaon Government College and Sherpur Palpara has been letting in flood water from the Chhota Jamuna river.

Government has taken up a plan for construction of a new embankment in the area to close the gap. But the subsidiary project, estimated to cost Tk 23 crore is yet to be approved by the central authorities.

Local leaders and agriculturists apprehended that the project area would be flooded again in the coming season, rendering the vast land uncultivable.
