3 youngmen arrested

Taposh killing

The Detective Branch (DB) of the Dhaka Metropolitan Police yesterday arrested three youngmen from Dhanmondi and Keraniganj areas after a 48hour long drive, for their alleged involvement in the killing of Fakhrul Islam Taposh, marketing officer of a Tannery at Hajaribagh Bhagolpur Lane, reports BSS.

Police said, a team of DB led by assistant commissioner Akram Hossain arrested Anwar Hossain alias Ripon (26). Mostafizur Rahman alias Badu (23) and Golam Dastogir alias Badal(24) from Dhanmondi and Keraniganj areas. Police also recovered a double barrel gun, a costape and a hammer, which were used in the killing, from the house of Golam Dastagir at 128 Kalabagan, on the basis of

their confessional statement. Police said, the arrested persons called Taposh from Jhigatola to the Kalabagan residence of Badal on Monday last. They killed him by beating with a hammer and finally left his body to a place nearby Mirpur

Taposh was a paying guest at Jhigatola residence of arrested Mustafizur Rahman and serving as a marketing officer of a tennery at Hajaribagh. He hailed from Dewra village un-der Sarail thana of Brahmanbaria district. He had his Masters degree in Commerce from Dhaka University in 1990.

World Health Day to be observed today 19,000 die from pregnancy related problems yearly'

Each hour records three deaths of women from pregnancy-related problems lead-ing to a total figure of 19,000 every year in Bangladesh, reports BSS.

This was disclosed by State Minister for Health and Family Welfare Dr M Amanullah at a press conference in the city yesterday on the eve of the World Health Day to be observed throughout Bangladesh today two day's ahead of the global schedule due to the holy Eid-Ul-

He said 70 per cent of such deaths were being caused due to the malnutrition problems compounded by various socioeconomic reasons and adversities created after 1975.

The main function of the day will be inaugurated by President Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed at Bangladesh National Museum auditorium at 11:30 am.

State Minister for Health and Family Welfare Dr M Amanullah and secretary of the Ministry M Mohammad Ali will lead a rally from National Museum to National Press Club in the morning as part of the day's programme.

This year's World Health Day with the theme pregnancy is special: let's make it safe" coincides with the 50th founding anniversary of World Health Organisation (WHO).

Referring to the constitutional provision for proper health care kept by father of the nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman in 1972. Dr Amanullah said the present government gave due importance on this vital sector in all best possible ways.

He said Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina declared May 28 as Safe Motherhood Day. "The health and population

President, PM's messages

President Shahabuddin Ahmed yesterday called for generating awareness about safety of pregnant mothers to reduce mother and child mortality rate in the country, reports BSS.

"It is of utmost importance to ensure safety and service to pregnant mothers to reduce the mortality rate," he said in a message on the occasion of World Health Day 1998. In a separate message Prime

Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday laid emphasis on strengthening health education campaign for reducing mother and child mortality rate in the country "Compared to other develop-

ing countries, child and mother mortality rate in Bangladesh is much higher. We all have come forward to ensure services during pregnancy or safe motherhood to keep pace of socio-economic development reducing the mortality rate," she said

sector strategy (HAPSS) designed for five years by the present government kept the provision for essential service package (ESP) for safe motherhood and childhood," he said.

Giving a reference to the dismal picture in the overall situation from 1976 to 1990, Dr Amanullah said Bangladesh had to shoulder a total loan amount of Taka 37,000 crore but there was no growth in any sector including the health during that period.

The press conference was also addressed by health secretary M Mohammad Ali, director general of Health Services, representatives of UNICEF UNFPA and World Bank and Brig (retd) Dr Shahjahan Hafiz of the WHO Dhaka Office.

The resident representative of WHO, Dhaka Office, Dr W Hardjotanojo was in the chair. He said the annual maternal deaths in pregnancy related problems was 600,000 in the whole world.

"The maternal mortality is very high in developing countries including Bangladesh," he said, adding that this phenomenon was still an indicator between rich and poor across the world.

. The WHO representative also said that such problem could be addressed easily through technical interventions but such steps required commitment as well as active collaboration of the agencies in

"Our collaborative agencies in the UN systems and those of the national and international NGOs side by side the government itself are fully devoted to ensure safe motherhood in Bangladesh," he said.


