Kenyan military team calls on President

The visiting Kenyan chief of general staff, Gen DRC Tonje, made a courtesy call on President Shahabuddin Ahmed at Bangabhaban yesterday, reports BSS.

Welcoming Gen Tonje President Shahabuddin said Bangladesh and Kenya are two friendly countries having excellent bilateral relations. He appreciated the existing good and cordial ties between the armies of both the countries.

The President stressed the need for wider cooperation between the two armies specially in various training courses. He mentioned that Kenyan officers had been attending special courses in Bangladesh since 1981. He observed that both the armies could send military observer teams to witness each other's collective exercises.

Gen Tonje thanked the President for receiving him and the members of his delegation. He appreciated the cordial hospitality extended to them by their counterparts in Bangladesh. The general hoped that cooperation between the two armies would be strengthened in the future.

Chief of Army Staff Lt Gen Mustafizur Rahman and members of the delegation were present on the occasion.

Dhaka-Aricha road repair work to be completed soon

The repair work of Dhaka-Aricha highway, costing Tk 150 crore, is nearing completion, reports UNB.

A total of 40 bridges have repaired and four others renovated on the 66-km road so far. The repair work is expected to be completed by June next.

The construction of the highway from Savar to Aricha began in June, 1995 with financial assistance from the Danish government.

Canadian minister calls on Matia, Abul Hasan Chy

The visiting Canadian Minister for International Cooperation Diane Marleau called on Food and Agriculture Minister Matia Chowdhury at her Bangladesh Secretariat office yesterday, reports UNB.

They discussed matters of mutual interest, specially the agriculture development and food security in Bangladesh. Matia Chowdhury sought cooperation of Canada in surface water management through dredging rivers and canals.

The rural infrastructure development programme, Food for Education Programme and promoting exports of agro-products also came up during their discussion.

The Canadian minister assured of her country's increasing cooperation in different agricultural development programmes of the Bangladesh government.

Agriculture Secretary, Dr AMM Shawkat Ali, Canadian High Commissioner in Bangladesh Nicholas Etheridge and other members of the delegation were present at the meeting.

Another report adds: Canadian Minister for International Cooperation Diane Marleau has praised the government for signing the CHT peace treaty, ending the long-running insurgency in the region.

Her appreciation came when she called on State Minister for Foreign Affairs Abul Hasan Chowdhury at his office yesterday.

During the meeting, they had a wide ranging discussion on issues of mutual interests.

Cellular mobile telephone service of Seba Telecom opens in city

Minister for Post, Telecommunications, Public Works and Housing Mohammad Nasim yesterday inaugurated the cellular mobile telephone service of Seba Telecom by making a direct call over mobile telephone to Mayor of Dhaka City Corporation Mohammad Hanif, reports BSS.

Speaking on the occasion, Nasim said the government of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina had given much importance to the expansion of the telecommunications system, its improved services for the socio-economic development of the country.

In this context, he said, the telecommunications sector has been kept open for the private entrepreneurs side by side with the public sector.

The minister expressed the hope that three licence holder private cellular mobile telephone organisations would continue their services to ensure multifarious facilities to the subscribers. Thanking the organisers of the Seba Telecom, Nasim said the goal of the Seba Telecom organisation should be to improve the subscribers services.

The minister also assured that necessary cooperation from the ministry for improving the services of the telephone would be provided.

DUTA concerned at hospital facilities

The Dhaka University Teachers' Association (DUTA) yesterday expressed concern at the existing treatment facilities in the country's hospitals and alleged "irresponsibility" on the part of concerned authorities in providing timely medicare, reports BSS.

DUTA president Prof AFM Yusuf Hyder and general secretary Prof Hossain Mansoor yesterday condoled recent tragic deaths of three Dhaka University students — Shaiful Islam of Soil Science Department, Sharmin Sultana Putul of Social Science Department and Nazrul Islam of Islamic Studies Department.

In a joint statement, they said while Shaiful Islam died allegedly due to error in treatment, Nazrul Islam died on his way to Salmullah Medical College Hospital after failing to get a seat at Dhaka Medical College Hospital.

The DUTA leaders urged the authorities to take immediate steps for improving hospital conditions.

US Embassy holiday

The consular section of the American Embassy will remain closed for non-immigrant visa (NV) services April 13, reports UNB.

A USIS press release yesterday said, the consular section will, however, be open on the day for American citizen services and interviews for immigrant visas.

It requested the applicants wishing to apply for NVs to do so on April 12 or 15 during normal working hours. Non-immigrant visas include tourists, business and student visas.
