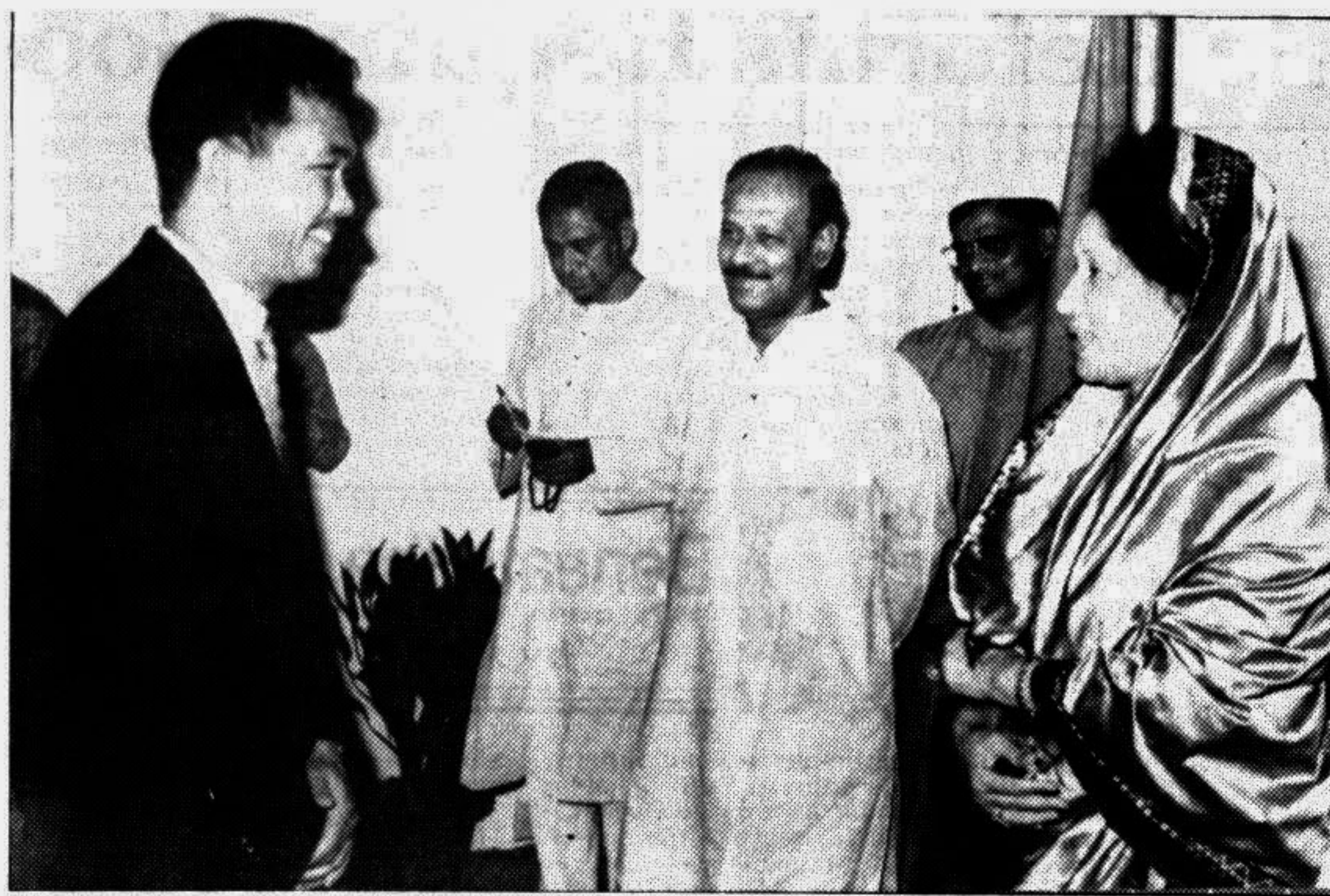
KHULNA, Apr 10: Holy Eid ul-Azha was celebrated here with due religious fervour and enthusiasm, reports BSS.

Mayor supervises DCC's waste disposal drive

Mayor of Dhaka City Mohammad Hanif visited different areas of the city for the third consecutive day yesterday to supervise the waste disposal drive launched on Eid day, reports BSS.

A 20-member high-powered task force formed earlier for the purpose, under the leadership of ward commissioners Abdul Gaffar and Raif Ali Bhuiyan and chief executive of DCC Rashidul Alam, also visited different areas to supervise the removal of remains of sacrificial animals, said a DCC press release.

Meanwhile, city dwellers have been requested to contact at telephone numbers 9556015 and 9004734 in Nagar Bhaban control room for quick disposal of any remains, found anywhere.

BSEHR survey Crime on rise in country

Crime marked an alarming rise across the country in last three months, signalling a deterioration in the overall law and order situation, reports UNB.

According to a survey conducted by Bangladesh Society for the Enforcement of Human Rights (BSEHR), some 714 people, including 130 women, were killed in different violent incidents during the period.

The report showed that 37 were killed in mass beatings while 18 in police custody. Besides, 144 people committed suicide due to various reasons.

During the period, 90 women and children were abducted and trafficked out of country while 105 people rescued from the hands of traffickers.

The report said 49 people, most of them women and teenagers girls, fell victim to acid throwing during the period.

It said sexual harassment also marked a rise during the time compared to the corresponding period of the last year. A total of 187 women, the majority of them women and teenagers girls, were violated. Of them, 90 were gang raped.

Twenty-three women were repressed by their greedy husbands and in-laws for dowry. Of them, three were killed and two committed suicide, the report said.
