

Australia's Test captain, won't plav international one-day cricket again, team coach Geoff Marsh was quoted today as saying, reports AFP. Marsh, with the Australian one-day team in India, says an era has finished and Australian cricket had to move on and find



the right captain to handle both the national Test and limitedover teams. Marsh was widely quoted in today's Australian newspapers on the dilemma confronting Australian cricket, with Taylor

and several leading Test stars at odds with Australia's new policy of selecting separate teams for Tests and one-day internationals. Taylor, senior wicketkeeper lan Healy, batsmen Greg Blewett, Michael Slater and spin bowler Stuart MacGill returned home last week after the

completion of the three-Test series, won 2-1 by India. They were replaced with oneday specialists, who are currently playing in a triangular tournament against India and Zimbabwe.

Taylor was last week vocal in his criticism of the two teams policy, which has him leading the Test side, but not deemed worthy of playing in the abbreviated one-day game. But Marsh has indicated that there may be little option but for Taylor to retire from international cricket in the interests of uniting the two Australian teams under one cap-

"We have to sort that problem out, because he (Taylor) won't play one-day cricket again." Marsh was quoted as saying. "Adam Gilchrist and Mark Waugh will open the batting for Australia.

"We've sat here (in India) reading the articles about Mark saying he's not happy with it. But we've got to do the best we

"I think Stephen's (Waugh) handled it quite well. Mark's obviously disappointed, and feels as though he's lost the ownership of the team. He's "But an era has finished. We've got to move on and find

been a fantastic captain for us. the right captain, if we are going to have one captain. The selectors might wait another 12 months before deciding who that is.

Marsh said the players would adjust to the two teams selection policy.

"I think it's worked okay. It's been different, but we're playing a lot more cricket now than three years ago. We have to change. The players will get used to it, because that's they way it's going to be.

"If you are looking for reasons why we haven't played well (in India), it's because we haven't made runs consistently use that as an excuse, not the two captains thing."




