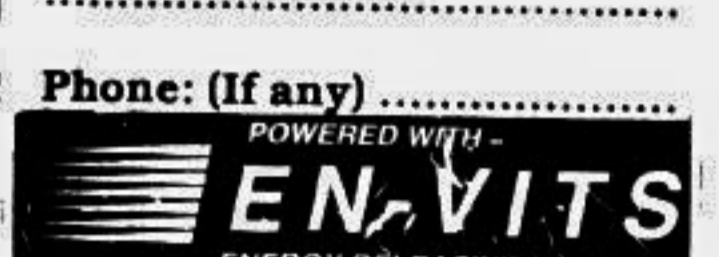

Pak pace puzzles Lankans

PAARL, South Africa, Apr 10: Pakistan on Thursday romped to a 110-run victory over Sri Lanka in their one-day match in Paarl to move closer to a final against hosts South Africa, reports Reuters.

Set to make 250, the world champions were bowled out for 139 in only 34.2 overs to suffer a third successive defeat in the triangular tournament. Sri Lanka need to win their three remaining matches to have any chance of reaching the final. Pakistan and South Africa each have two wins, the latter having played only two matches.

Fiery pace bowling by Wasim Akram and Waqar Younis set Pakistan on course for victory. Sri Lanka were reduced to 54 for four by the 12th over. ... Off-spinners Muttiah Muralitharan got three of the wickets but Ijaz Ahmed, in his 200th one-day international,

crused to a stylish 65 and good contributions came from down the order. Rashid Latif (36), Akram (22) and Razzaq (22) ensured Pakistan posted a more than reasonable total. South Africa meet Pakistan in East London tomorrow.

Inzamam stymies world champions

KIMBERLEY, South Africa, Apr 10: Inzamam-ul-Haq returned to form with a hard-hitting century as Pakistan pulled off a thrilling win over Sri Lanka at Kimberley Cricket Club on Tuesday, reports AFP.

Inzamam hammered 116 not out off 110 balls as Pakistan made 300 for six in 48 overs to achieve their highest winning total in the second innings of a one-day match.

Sri Lanka had seemingly made a safe total of 295 for seven with skipper Arjuna Ranatunga making 86 off 82 balls. Pakistan had to make their runs in 49 overs after being penalised one over because of a slow over-rate during Sri Lanka's innings.

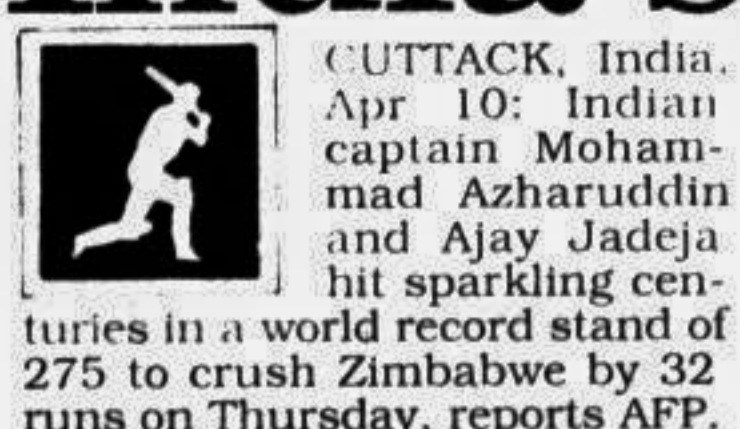
Hosts ease into final

CUTTACK, India, Apr 10: Indian captain Mohammad Azharuddin and Ajay Jadeja hit sparkling centuries in a world record stand of 275 to crush Zimbabwe by 32 runs on Thursday, reports AFP.

Skipper Azharuddin scored an unbeaten 153 off 149 balls and Jadeja made 116 not out, as India recovered from 26 for three to post 301 without further loss in 50 overs after being sent to bat on a damp wicket.
