**Minister visits Siddhirganj power centre**

**'PM keen to set up ultra-modern relay coordination centre'**

Minister of State for Power, Energy and Mineral Resources, Prof Rafiqul Islam yesterday paid a surprise visit to the system control room of DESA, load despatching centre (LDC), power centre and grid sub-station at Siddhirganj, reports BSS. During the visit, the state minister examined the date-wise receiving and despatching of power both at DESA control room and Siddhirganj LDC and found some discrepancies. Prof Rafique asked the concerned authorities at both the points to develop better communications between the DESA system control room and Siddhirganj LDC and curb the system loss by 12 per cent. He told the officials that Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina had been keenly watching the development efforts for the improvement of power distribution system in the country, particularly in the Dhaka city. The state minister said the prime minister was keen to set up an ultra-modern relay coordination centre for distribution of power. The centre will check disruption of power supply in the national grid. Under an auto system, the ultra-modern relay centre will help suspend the supply of power in the concerned portion but maintain transmission and distribution of power in the rest portions of the national grid.

**Int'l confce on health and environment  
Apr 16**

Minister for Health and Family Welfare Salah Uddin Yusuf will present the key-note address to the seventh Annual International Conference on Health and Environment on April 16, reports UNB. According to a message received from New York on Friday, the theme of his address will be "Trauma of Environmental Disasters: Consequences to Human Health". The conference will be held in UN Conference Room 2 as a two-day event with morning and afternoon sessions. Opening remarks on the first meeting will be made by Hennadiy Udovenko, President of the 52nd session of the General Assembly and Ambassador and permanent representative of Bangladesh Anwarul Karim Chowdhury to the United Nations, among others. This will be followed by presentations from resource persons. The permanent mission of Bangladesh to the United Nations will be co-sponsoring along with the World Information Transfer, a non-governmental organisation in consultative status with the United Nations.

**Dhaka-Ctg non-stop train service from Apr 14**

CHITTAGONG, Apr 11: Bangladesh Railway will introduce non-stop inter-city train service on Chittagong-Dhaka route from April 14, reports BSS. The "Subarna Express" will leave Chittagong station at 7 am and reach Dhaka at 12 noon and on return journey, it will leave Dhaka at 5 pm and reach Chittagong at 10 pm every day, says a Railway press release today. Bangladesh Railway will be appointed this month. The Vice-Chancellor of the Bangladesh Sheikh Mujib Medical University will be appointed this month, reports UNB. The likely candidates for the post include National Professor Dr Nurul Islam, who is also the President of University of Science and Technology, Chittagong (USTC). Other candidates are: Prof Mohammed Tahir, Director of IPGMR, Dr M A Quadri, former Professor of Medicine at the Dhaka Medical College Hospital, and Dr M Suhrah Ali, Prof of Biochemistry Department at the IPGMR and Dean of the Faculty of Post-Graduate Medical Science and Research. According to official sources, the Health Ministry will issue a notification by April 20 on the functioning of the Institute of Post-Graduate Medicine and Research (IPGMR) as the Bangladesh Sheikh Mujib Medical University. On March 23, Parliament passed the Bangladesh Sheikh Mujib Medical University Bill 1998. President Shahabuddin Ahmed gave his assent to the Bill on April 5.
