power tariff has been increased by only Tk 0.45 from March, and the decision for further increase is now being delayed because of the disastrous impact it will have on the country's economy. It is now being considered that this hike will be made in phases once the gas tariff is relaxed. There is a proposal to increase the tariff by 31 per cent from this month.

Meanwhile, the performance of PDB and DESA worsened sharply in the past years. PDB's collection-generation ratio is now 59.6 per cent which means for every 100 kw of power generated, it gets payment for only 59.6 kw.

The World Bank has observed that the PDB had been too much pre-occupied with IPP and ignored improving its own performance. Some plants which needed attention are now inoperative. Therefore, the payment for private power has become uncertain.

"We have started with IPPs without any preparation. It is because, by stopping financing the public sector power projects from 1991, the donors compelled us to resort to IPPs as the only solution for the power sector. We had no experience when we started," PDB Chairman Nuruddin M Kamal told the Daily Star.

"Yes, there are worries about financial matters relating to IPP. But there are many fields where PDB is not getting the opportunities offered to the IPPs. If PDB was given the same financial benefits, including 15 years of tax holiday for new plants, PDB could have improved its performance," he said.

"PDB cannot even assert its vested power to increase 10 per cent tariff to make its operation profitable. Decisions on tariff is taken by the Finance Ministry," he added hinting that the power sector needed to be directed in an organised manner which did not exist now.

Nuruddin M Kamal noted that the collection-generation and system loss of PDB, DESA and REB have to be dealt with from the highest authorities of the government and that intense pressure must be put on the power purchasers from PDB to repay their dues.

PDB envisages that by the year 2000-2001, Bangladesh will get 300 MW power from three barge mounted plants, 450 MW from Meghnaghat, 360 MW from Haripur, 310 MW from Unocha's West Region Integrated Project and 100 MW from Midland Power's Baghabari power plant.

In addition to these private schemes, government schemes will add more power to the national grid. These include 210 MW 6th unit of Ghorashal plant, two 210 MW units of Rajan plant (which now produce a maximum of 200 MW due to gas supply shortfall) and Shajibazar 60 MW plant of Rural Power Company.

In other words, Bangladesh will get 1840 MW more power supply in addition to the existing 1800 MW to 2200 MW after a couple of years. This totals the actual projected power generation of 3600 MW to 4000 MW. This projection complies with the Power System Master Plan of the government.

Wartsila is currently working in Khulna to build a 100 MW barge mounted plant. It is expected to be completed by August, according to the PDB chairman.

Smith Cogeneration, after signing the contract for setting up a plant in Khulna five months ago, remains missing from the scenario. The PDB chairman said that the PDB sent over a dozen letters to Smith Cogeneration asking for explanation for not doing work as per schedule, but it did not reply. "It seems that this company is having some kind of financial problem," he said.

A third contract was signed by the PDB with Wartsila. However, Wartsila did not originally bid for this plant, to be set up in Haripur. The original bidder for this plant was New England which failed to submit financial guarantee after it was declared the best bidder. Due to its inexperience and fund shortage, it later brought in US company Enron as its partner. Then Enron walked out and New England brought in Wartsila as the Engineering Procurement Contractor. Finally, PDB signed contract recently with Wartsila violating its own bidding rules.

Meanwhile, the southern Chittagong region has about 300 mw potential surplus. It has two 210 mw units at Rajan, 230 mw Kaptai plant, 60 mw Sikabaha plant and a 50 mw barge mounted plant totalling some 760 mw. But Chittagong can consume a maximum of 350 mw, leaving 300 mw surplus.

But much of this surplus power cannot be transferred to other power hungry areas of the country because of inadequate transmission system. The existing 132 kv line set up in 1962 can at best carry some 150 mw. To increase the transmission capacity, the government initiated a negotiation with a donor agency, KfW of Germany in 1992 to set up a 230 kv line. But due to a number of reasons, the negotiations extended to 1997 and the PDB and KfW signed a contract.

KfW set terms that PDB has to improve its bill collection.

In such a situation, PDB took its own move to set up a low cost single circuit 132 kv line, having a capacity to transmit 120 MW power with a budget of about tk 70 crore. This project is expected to be completed in July next, allowing Chittagong region to supply about 250 MW to 270 MW power.

At the same time, KfW agreed to look into the shortcomings of the PDB and re-opened negotiations for the 230 kv line. It is likely that KfW may agree to resume financing this project soon, the PDB chairman said.
