

Prices of hides at lowest ebb in Kushtia dist

From Our Correspondent KUSHTIA, Apr 13: Prices of hides and skins of sacrificial animals have come down to the lowest ebb due to shortage of buyers in the district.

Hides and skin of about one lakh sacrificial animals are being purchased by middlemen and traders at throw away prices. These are being stored at convenient places to hand over to smugglers as the prices of hides and the skins are also low in Dhaka.

A number of Indian agents intruded into Bangladesh territory to collect those and help smuggled out the skins. Finding the market very dull, local traders are compelled to sell those to the smugglers.

Border points from where those skins and hides are being smuggled out are; Pragpur. Bazumara of Daulatpur thana, Kazipur, Hizalbaria. Shaharbati villages of Gangni thana.

MAGURA, Apr 13: Envi- Jhenidah, Jessore, Narail, agement. Khulna, Bagerhat, Satkhira Kushtia, Chuadanga and Meherpur districts use ground water for cultivation of transplanted Boro paddy through deep and shallow pumps. Transplanted Boro paddy growers are compelled to use ground water pumping through deep tubewells (DTs) or

Shallow Tubewells (STs). According to the sources, use of shallow pumps are being increased in this region of the country.

A source of Agriculture Extension Department (AED) said. 92 thousand 252 shallow tubewells are being used in the above mentioned districts. About 6 lakh 4 thousand 6 hundred acres of land are being cultivated through shallow tube-

during the current season.

Local experts have appre-hended, it would keep an adverse effect on environment. Environmental experts have opined that proper use of ground water would help check degradation of environment. They have urged the authorities concerned to take proper steps with a view to protecting environment.

Breach in dam Crops on 15,000 acres of land damaged

SYLHET, Apr 13: Crops on 15,000 acres of land at Gurapur, Maijail and Chatal beel area in Balaganj thana here have been damaged due to a breach developed in the embankment of a canal, reports UNB.

Local farmers said the embankment on Kupir canal at the eastern side of the thana has been damaged causing inundation of the crop lands. They said the loss is heavy and unbearable for them.

The local people have been demanding construction of a sluice gate at the point where the embankment was damaged. But they alleged that the authorities paid no heed to the demand.

They said the authorities reportedly gave some allocations for the earthwork of the embankment, but there is no initiative yet to repair the dam-

The villagers could not take any step to repair the damages at their own initiative as most of them were charged in some cases of police assault and possessing of illegal arms.

MOULVIBAZAR, Apr 13: The Greater Sylhet Development and Welfare Council (GSDWC) in the United Kingdom (UK) demanded immediate fulfilment of 9-point demands of Bangladeshi people residing abroad.

This demand was made at a press conference of GSDWC, UK held at Moulvibazar Pourasava auditorium recently. A K M Abu Taher Chowdhury, General Secretary of GSDWC, UK read out his written speech in the press conference and replied to different questions of journalists.

The leader of GSDWC, UK demanded pressure from the Bangladesh Government on the British Government to withdraw ban on export of Bangladeshi fishes to the European countries and set up a consular section of British High Commission in Sylhet. Bangladesh Government should taken necessary steps to create healthy environment for foreign investment, he opined.

Other demands included, enlistment of the name of Bangladeshi people, who reside abroad in the voters' list, reinvestigation of Surat Miah murder case, stopping harassment of the passengers by Immigration and Customs staffers in Dhaka and Sylhet Airport, upgradation of Sylhet MAG Osmany Airport as an International airport.
