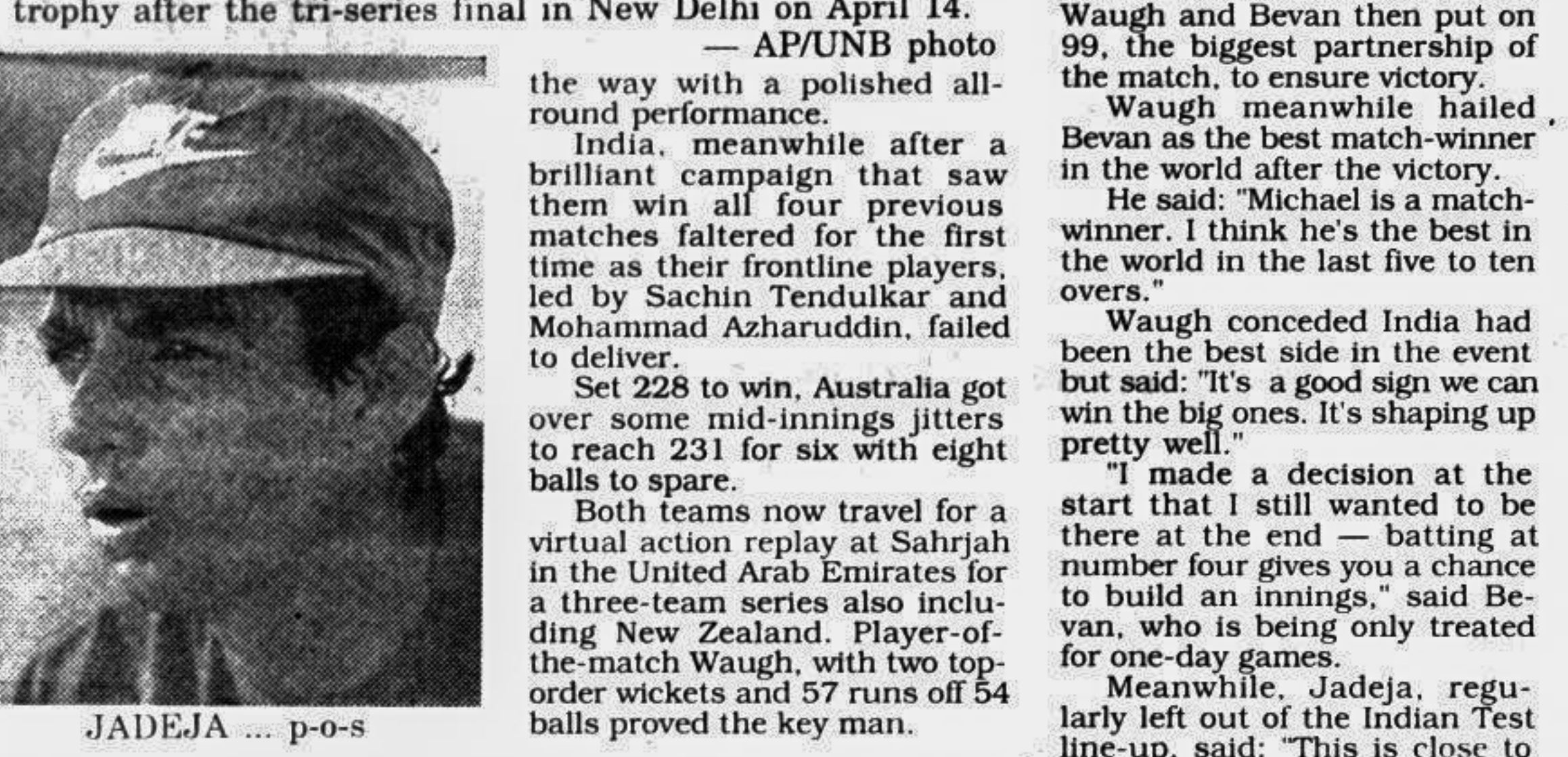

Steve has the last laugh

New Delhi, Apr 15: Steve Waugh's bruised and battered Australians salvaged some pride here Tuesday by beating India by four wickets in the final of a tri-nation one-day tournament, reports AFP.

India, meanwhile after a brilliant campaign that saw them win all four previous matches faltered for the first time as their frontline players, led by Sachin Tendulkar and Mohammad Azharuddin, failed to deliver.

Set 228 to win, Australia got over some mid-innings jitters to reach 231 for six with eight balls to spare.

Both teams now travel for a virtual action replay at Sharjah in the United Arab Emirates for a three-team series also including New Zealand. Player-of-the-match Waugh, with two top-order wickets and 57 runs off 54 balls proved the key man.
