Chaired by ICC president Jagmohan Dalmya, the committee also includes the ICC executive secretary Dave Richardson, the chairman of the ICC financial committee Ehsan Mani, and the managing director of United Cricket Board of South Africa Dr. Ali Bacher.

Syed Ashraful Haque, the general secretary of BCB, will be the Co-ordinator of the tournament while former Pakistan captain Asif Iqbal will act as Event Manager during the 10day long gala event.

Meanwhile, the board formed a ten-member preparatory committee for the Wills International Cup headed by Saber Hossain Chowdhury Syed Ashraful Haque will be the member-secretary of the committee which also includes the five vice-presidents, the twojoint-secretaries and the treasurer of the board.




