AL to party activists Remain alert against vested quarters

Awami League leaders at a discussion yesterday called upon the party workers to remain alert against the vested quarters who are trying to foil the progress of democracy led by the government of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, reports BSS.

They also underscored the need for unity among the pro-liberation forces for resisting any kind of conspiracy in the name of opposition political movement inside and outside the parliament.
The discussion was organised by the city unit of Awami League to mark the historic Mujibnagar Day in the city yesterday afternoon at the party office.

Chaired by City Awami League president and Mayor of Dhaka Mohammad Hanif, it was addressed, among others, by Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Minister Abdul Matin Khasru, State Minister for LGRD and Cooperatives Mofazzal Hossain Chowdhury Maya, Mofazzal Hossain Paltu, Azizur Rahman, Abdul Mannan, Mukul Bose, Alamgir Kumum, Nurul Siddiqur, Rauf Khan, Nurul Fazal, Bulbul, Reazuddin Ahmed, Akhtarul Alam, Qamrul Islam, Salahuddin Badal and Srani League leader Ah-sanullah Master, MP.

Law Minister Abdul Matin Khasru said, "The formation of Mujibnagar government 27 years ago, headed by the elected representatives of Awami League under the directives of Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman, had inspired the disappointed Bangladeshis to participate in the War of Liberation against the Pakistani occupation forces." "April 17 of 1971 is one of the milestones in our history. This is our national achievement. So there should not be any difference of opinion in this regard."

State Minister for LGRD Mofazzal Hossain Chowdhury Maya urged the party workers to remain alert against those who are trying to undermine the parliament in the name of opposition movement.

In his presidential speech city Mayor Mohammad Hanif said the observance of the historic Mujibnagar Day would be meaningful when the nation would attain economic solvency.

Addressing the rally, LDF central leader A F M Mahbubul Haq said public life has become miserable due to water and gas crises accompanied by load-shedding.

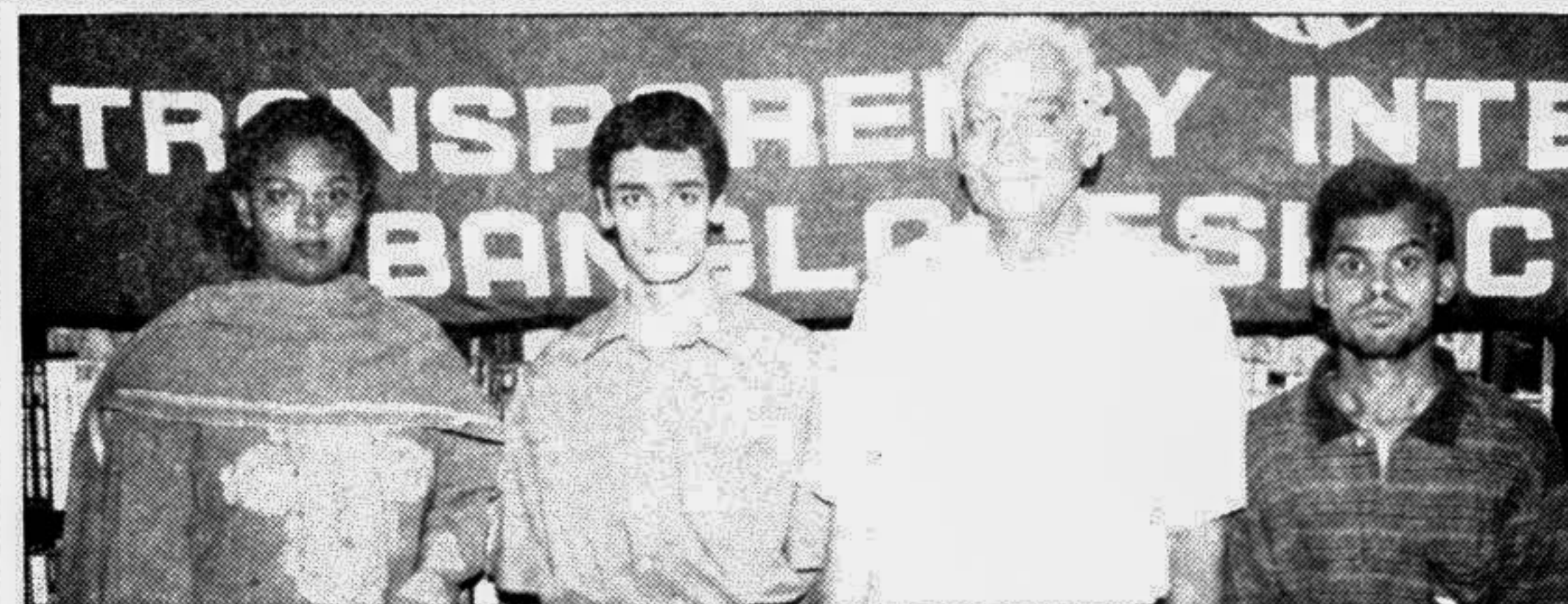
Anjan Datta in city

GRC assures BDRCS of continued support

Visiting German Red Cross (GRC) delegation yesterday assured the Bangladesh Red Crescent Society (BDRCS) of continuing its support to BDRCS activities in the field of disaster management, cyclone preparedness programme (CPP) and community health services in the coastal and offshore islands, reports BSS.

The assurance came after talks between GRC and BDRCS officials at the BDRCS's headquarters at Bara Maghbaraz in the city.

John Wilhelm Romer and Major (ret'd) Ali Hassan Quore-shi, secretary generals of GRC and BDRCS led their respective sides at the talks.

Earlier, Romer along with Johannes Richard, head of the inter-relation operation of GRC had a meeting with BDRCS vice chairman Touhidur Rahman.

The leader of the GRC also visited some BDRCS projects in Cox's Bazar, Chokoria and Maheshkhali islands.

New medicine for breast cancer available in country

France-based pharmaceutical company Rhone-Poulenc Rorer has recently invented a new type of cancer medicine 'Taxotere' which is highly effective in breast cancer and some of lung cancers. The medicine is now available in the country, says a press release.

It is estimated that globally 15-20 per cent of cancer patients are suffering from breast cancer. Widespread use of contraceptive pills, reluctance for breast feeding, environmental pollution and cancer medicine largely contributes to the increased incidence of breast cancer during the last decades.

Till now the chemotherapy used for breast cancer are not very much effective, in contrary side effects are sometimes fatal. Usual side effects of cancer medications are normally rare with Taxotere.

Two years back Taxotere was launched in the world market, but it was not available in Bangladesh. Patients had to face enormous sufferings to collect the medicine either from Singapore or India.

Lately Rhone-Poulenc Rorer Bangladesh Ltd has obtained government permission from Drug Administration to market Taxotere in Bangladesh and they have made the product available from March.

Zillur, Ivy perform Hajj

Awami League General Secretary and LGRD and Cooperatives Minister Zillur Rahman returned home yesterday from Saudi Arabia after performing Hajj there, reports BSS. Wife of the minister, Ivy Rahman, also performed holy Hajj along with her husband.
