

# Devise ways to raise output, PM urges agriculturists

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina yesterday called upon the agriculturists to find out ways of increasing production in the limited lands of the country to free the nation from hunger, reports UNB.

"The government has targeted to build up a hunger-free nation and laid utmost importance on agriculture — the main source of national income," she

The Prime Minister was addressing the newly elected office bearers of the Krishibid Institution at her office.

About a dozen members of the institution, including the newly elected leaders, led by its Chairman Enamul Huq and Secretary General Abdul Mannan, came to meet the Prime Minister.

Hasina said Bangladesh is a land of agriculture and the contribution of agriculture is enormous in the country's economy. So, the government has given special importance for boosting agricultural production.

"The country's population, currently 120 million, is rising day by day; but the land is not increasing. So, we'll have to innovate a system to increase production," she said.

She said the growth rate of the country has increased last year, estimated at 5.9 per cent. Of this, the contribution of agriculture was very significant - more than 6 per cent.

About the rise of prices of agricultural products, Hasina said when production increases, the price falls and when production decreases, then the price shoots up creating problem for the poor consumers.

And there should be some sort of mechanism to strike a balance between production and prices for the sake of both producers and consumers, she

Referring to the need for proper and optimum use of land, the Prime Minister said the officials of Agriculture Department should motivate people to use all their lands - fer-


tile or fallow. In this regard, she said the government has already directed the concerned authorities not to allow the use of fertile lands for constructing buildings, nor for industries. Use

Bangladesh Rifles has de-molished poppy seeds on 107.88 acres of land in Balipara of Bandarban district at the instruction of the authority concerned, reports UNB.

Opium, a kind of drug is made from poppy seeds. These lands are located under CIO camps in Modok, Chhotomodhu, Dalianpara, Ionrai, Tendumukh and Thanchi where poppy seeds were being cultivated in large scale, said a press release yesterday.

The Police or the Dhaka City Corporation (DCC) was yet to trace the driver or the container garbage truck that killed a 36-year-old businessman late Friday night on Abdul Gani Road near the Secretariat.

Samiruddin Ahmed was killed instantly when the DCC truck smashed his Vespa from the wrong side of the road and later crushed him under its wheel and fled. Samir's wife sustained serious injury and his seven-year-old son escaped unhurt in the accident.

DCC sources said they had questioned several drivers and sweepers of the 104-truck fleet of the container garbage trucks but could not find any clue.
