

# Akram on bribery affair

LONDON, Apr 20: Former Pakistan captain Wasim Akram has vehemently denied allegations that he was bribed to influence the results of oneday internationals, reports Reuters.

Under Akram, Pakistan lost to England and West Indies in the Sharjah one-day tournament last December.

In an extract from his autobiography published in today's Daily Mail, Akram said he had played poorly in Sharjah. "When we got back to Pakistan. the temperature had really risen," he wrote.

"Former Test players had put their names to ridiculous newspaper articles, saying that the reason we had lost in Sharjah was because we had taken bribes to throw games. "Some papers reported that I

had made a lot of money out of

losing those two games and that one of my brothers is a bookmaker so he had the inside track. It didn't matter that neither of my brothers has ever been a bookmaker. "I have never attempted to throw a match and have never

even considered such a thing for a second. I have no concrete knowledge of any Pakistan player taking money to influence events on the field. "This is a slur that just won't go away in Pakistan cricket."

Gambling on one-day matches has become an increasingly contentious issue. with Wisden editor Matthew Engel calling for an international industry. "Nobody doubts that this

gambling takes place for large sums and that cricketers are involved in the process," Engel wrote in his editor's notes for the 1998 edition.



Tendulkar, who began with three successive fours off fast bowler Michael Kasprowicz, raced to his 50 with five more

hits to the fence. But he managed just one more boundary after that, preferring to rotate the strike with quick singles and twos.

Fleming. player-of-the-match against New Zealand for his four-wicket haul, finished with two for 35. Steve Waugh. who claimed the last three

wickets, had 4-40. Leg-spinner Shane Warne, however, produced the game's best delivery when he made one bounce and turn to catch Ajay Jadeja stranded out of his crease.

It was Australia's second win in as many games against India, having won last week's triseries final in New Delhi by four wickets.

India allowed Australia to add 37 runs off the last 22 deliveries after having them on the mat at 227-7. Australia's late charge was

led by Damien Martyn, who hit 30 off 28 balls, and Warne's long-handle which produced two fours and a six in 19 off 12.

Till they came to the crease, the Australians found runmaking difficult on a lifeless wicket where the ball did not come on to the bat.

Michael Bevan gave another glimpse of his value as a oneday batsman with a top-score of 58, composed entirely by brisk running between the wicket.

India's rookie 17-year-old off-spinner Harbhajan Singh claimed 3-41 from 10 overs in only his second one-dayer.

He made up for the absence of new-ball bowler, Ajit Agarkar, who claimed four wickets against New Zealand of Friday, but was forced to stand down with a groin injury.

India snatched the early advantage when they removed openers Mark Waugh and Gilchrist by the 10th over with

the score at 46. The second leg begins on Monday when India take on New Zealand.
