Workshop on 'Raising Environmental Awareness' held Effective partnership of developed, developing nations underscored

Discussants at a workshop in the city yesterday underscored the need for effective partnership of the developed and developing nations to help the poor countries attain sustainable development, reports UNB.

"We must work together if we are to make sustainable development a guiding principle of the 21st century and to create a better life for all our grandchildren," said John Kimcannon, Director of the United States Information Service (USIS), Dhaka.

The workshop on "Raising Environmental Awareness" was jointly organised by the Forum of Environmental Journalists of Bangladesh (FEJB) and the USIS at the National Press Club marking the Earth Day.

Kimcannon said that although the industrialised nations now emit the largest amount of greenhouse gases the developing nations will soon become the largest emitters.

The developing world, particularly two key nations India and China, may account for 40 per cent of all greenhouse gas emissions by the middle of the next century, he said.

At present, according to available statistics, the US is responsible for 22 per cent of global emission and countries of the Organisation for Economic Cooperation and Development (OECD) for almost 44 per cent.

The USIS Director said Bangladesh, with its land not more than three metres above sea level, may fall victim to global warming and a loss of even five or seven per cent of the land could have major human and economic consequences.

The catastrophe may cause millions of environmental refugees.

As a country with vital interest in global warming, Kimcannon said, there may be opportunities for Bangladesh to play an important leadership role on this issue in the developing world.

Rasheda K Choudhury of ADAB, FEJB Vice-Chairman Gazur Rahman, General Secretary Bakhtiar Rana and Chinnony Mutsuddy, Shehabuddin Ahmed, Mostafa Kamal Khan, Abdul Jalil Bhuiyan, Sarwar Jahan, Elahi Newaj Khan and Giasuddin Ahmed participated in the discussion chaired by FEJB Chairman Quamrul Islam Chowdhury.

Most speakers blamed the developed countries for the ecological mess that the earth finds itself in and said the richer countries should change their consumption pattern and assist the poor nations to efficiently improve their energy efficiency levels.

They also called for effective measures to limit population growth, prevent soil erosion, conserve scarce water resources and, above all, create environmental awareness among the people to save the earth from further degradation.

Outgoing Lankan High Commissioner meets President

The outgoing High Commissioner of Sri Lanka to Bangladesh S B Atugoda made a farewell call on President Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed at Bangabhaban yesterday, reports UNB.

President Shahabuddin appreciated Atugoda for his contribution in strengthening bilateral relations between the two countries which are based on common culture and heritage.

He hoped that both Bangladesh and Sri Lanka would continue to cooperate with each other on issues of common concern in regional and international forum.

President Shahabuddin observed that enhanced economic cooperation between the two countries will be mutually beneficial.
