**AI, Bangladesh launches 3-month campaign in South Asia**

Amnesty International Bangladesh yesterday launched a three-month campaign in South Asia to reinforce the implementation of UN Convention on the Rights of the Child (CRC) in the region, reports UNB.

The campaign has simultaneously been launched in Bangladesh and four other South Asian countries — India, Pakistan, Nepal and Sri Lanka.

Amnesty International Bangladesh (AIB) President Syed M Dastagir Hossain launched the campaign for Bangladesh at a press conference at National Press Club yesterday.

Justice KM Sobhan, UNICEF official Aung Tun The, Bangladesh Shishu Odhikar Forum Chairperson Sharif A Kafi and AIB Director Golam Mostafa addressed the press conference.

Children, who make up 40 per cent of the South Asian population, are exposed to bonded labour, trafficking and prostitution, Amnesty International reports.

The SAARC countries have ratified or acceded to the CRC, declared 1990s as the Decade of the Girl Child and going to begin SAARC Decade of the Rights of the Child from the year 2001.

Despite these commitments of the governments, children here are exposed to human rights violations at the hands of state agencies and abused by armed groups from arbitrary detention, cruel punishment and torture to killings, says the AI report.

The campaign aims at urging South Asian governments for taking immediate steps to protect children rights, raising awareness about children's rights in South Asia and encouraging people to take care of the future generation.

The campaign includes distribution of leaflets containing children rights on April 22-30, holding seminars and bringing out a children's rally on May 21, lobbying with government, meeting with NGOs and holding a children's painting competition in June, publication of poster and visit to South Asian embassies in Dhaka in July.

**JU 1st year (Hons) admission forms distribution begins**

Distribution of application forms for admission into the first year (Hons) classes of Jahangirnagar University (JU) under the session 97-98 begins today.

Each form for the Science Faculty (Ka unit) and the Arts Faculty (Ga unit) will cost Tk 150 while those of the Social Science Faculty (Kha unit) and the Life Science Institute (Gha unit) will cost Tk 125 each.

The applicants have been advised to collect their forms from each of Agrani Bank's Bangabandhu Avenue, Mirpur-1, New Market, Farmgate or JU branch, official sources said.

The applicants have also been asked to submit the forms at the Dean offices of the respective faculty by May 11 from 8 am to 2 pm.

The dates for the admission tests will be announced later.

**Priority laid on fisheries, livestock sectors: Satish**

State Minister for Fisheries and Livestock Satish Chandra Roy yesterday said the present government has laid priority on fisheries and livestock sector for poverty alleviation and socio-economic development of the country, reports BSS.

He was speaking as the chief guest at a seminar on 'important poultry diseases' held at a hotel here. Bengal Overseas Limited (BOL) organised the seminar.

Different types of diseases cause difficulties in the development of poultry sector, the state minister said adding, the government has taken a Taka sixty crore project for producing vaccine in the country.

Dr Margit Weingarten, Poultry Specialist of Intervet International BV, The Netherlands presented the key-note paper while Dr Kazi Abdul Fattah, Director General of Livestock Division, Dr MA Faiaz, Advisor of the BOL and M Sharafat Ullah, Chairman of BOL, spoke on the occasion.

**BNP Secy Gen concerned at leakage of SSC questions**

BNP Secretary General Abdul Mannan Bhuiyan has expressed concern over the leakage of SSC question papers and condemned the arrest of journalists in this connection, reports UNB.

In a statement yesterday, he said the government resorted to arrest and filing of false cases against newsmen instead of taking action against the real culprits.

"This inefficient government has failed to run the country on all accounts and even created a mass in education sector," he said.

Bhuiyan alleged that the leakage of question papers and adoption of unfair means in examinations have marked an unusual increase since the assumption of power by the Awami League government.

The BNP secretary general asked the government to stop harassment of journalists and the owners of newspapers, and withdraw the cases filed against them.

**ADB consultation meet held**

The Bangladesh Resident Mission (BRM) of the Asian Development Bank (ADB) organised a one-day consultation meeting on the Bank's Health Sector Policy at Hotel Sonargaon in Dhaka yesterday, says a press release.

The meeting was inaugurated by Muhammad Ali, Secretary, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare.

The welcome speech was addressed by Francis B Narayan, Office-in-Charge, BRM of ADB and the keynote paper was presented by Dr Benjamin Loevinsohn, Senior Health Specialist, ADB HQ, Manila.

The meeting was attended by as many as 45 distinguished physicians, scholars, NGO leaders, representatives from ICDDR,B including private agencies and government officials. With a view to improving the Bank's Health Sector Policy in Bangladesh by making it more responsive to the stakeholders like GOs, NGOs, academic institutions, private health care providers, feedbacks, opinions, comments and suggestions on the Bank's draft policy were obtained through threadbare discussion and meaningful interaction among the participants. The Secretary emphasised that the challenges that the health sector is facing are crucial tasks for us.

**Indian navy ships leave Ctg**

CHITTAGONG, Apr 22: The Indian navy ships, INS Tir and Ins Krishna left here today ending their four-day training-cum-goodwill visit to Bangladesh, reports BSS.

During their stay in Bangladesh, members of the Indian navy ships visited some of the training establishments of Bangladesh Navy in Chittagong. They also took part in friendly football and basketball matches with the local BN teams.

Besides, the ships were kept open to a limited number of visitors from armed forces, students of selected colleges and some members of Bangladesh National Cadet Corps, an ISPR press release said.

Earlier, senior officers of Bangladesh Navy and officials of the Indian High Commission in Bangladesh bade farewell to them prior to their departure from Chittagong harbour.

**Weather Rain with hails likely**
