Repression on women rises sharply

Repression on young women in the district of Feni has marked an alarming rise, creating panic among the school and college going girls, reports UNB.

According to an estimate, 23 young women and housewives were killed in last 20 months till August '97. Some of them committed suicide after being raped by miscreants.

Nine of the deaths were reported from Sadar thana, three each from Sonagazi and Daganbhuiyan, two from Chhaganaiya, five from Parshuram and one from Fulgazi thanas.

Besides, 18 housewives, three women and five school and college students were violated during the period. Eleven of them committed suicide just after the incidents.

BSCIC industrial area in Sherpur still wears a deserted look

The lone industrial area of Bangladesh Small and Cottage Industries Corporation (BSCIC) in Sherpur still wears a deserted look as it failed to set up a single industry there in last three years, reports UNB.

According to officials, the BSCIC authorities had started works on 15 acres of land in Nohatakalganj of the town in 1998 with a view to establishing an industrial belt, involving Tk 2.10 crore.

Meanwhile, development works on 10 acres of lands, construction of administrative building, staff quarters, roads, drainage, culvert and overhead tank, power connection and installation of deep tubewells, pipe line and pumps have been completed.

The authorities have also allotted 104 plots, including 78 for heavy industries, 16 for

small and 10 for other industrial units.

But they could not encourage the entrepreneurs to come up with their projects.

When contacted the authorities told UNB that the businessmen here are in fear that they would not be able to compete the products of Indian industries and those of capital Dhaka.

"Bottleneck in availing bank loan is another stumbling block to the development of industrial units in the area," said an official on condition of anonymity.

On the other hand, the authorities could not yet fix the land cost. Earlier, they fixed the land cost giving subsidy but later they had to withhold it in the face of pressure by the World Bank.

Beauty contest an act against humanity, Islam: Saidee

The organisers of the beauty pageant has been warned that they will be "burnt to ashes" if they don't stop the so-called contest, reports UNB.

Moulana Delwar Hossain Saidee MP gave the warning while addressing a rally, organised by Islami Sangram Parishad at Paltan Maidan in the city yesterday.

He termed the beauty contest, to be organised by Lever Brothers and Model Watch, "an act against humanity and Islam."

He said if necessary, the people of the country would compel the organisers to stop it.

"Muslims of Dhaka will not stay in their houses if the organisers continue their effort to hold the contest," said the leader of Jamaat-e-Islami.

Moulana Saidee said such indecent contest and pornographic films and magazines

inspire people to go for acts of violating women.

"It is the responsibility of the government to stop those," he said. "The government which can't protect dignity of women has no right to stay in power."

The rally was also addressed by Moulana Mohiuddin Khan of Islami Oikya Jote, A. T. M. Azharul Islam and Dr Syed Abdullah M Taher of Jamaat. Dr Hasanuzzaman Chowdhury, a former leftist and professor of Dhaka University, Jagga chief Shafiqul Alam Proddhan, Ehsanul Mahbub Jobaer of Islami Chhatra Shibir, Shibir Ahmed of Madrasa Chhatra Andolon and Dr Shah M Emdadul Haq of Islami Morcha.

Later, the activists of the Islami Sangram Parishad brought out a procession that paraded different city streets, said a press release.

Diarrhoea breaks out in epidemic form in Pirojpur

Diarrhoea broke out in Pirojpur district in an epidemic form affecting over 100 people on Thursday, according to unofficial sources, reports UNB.

But officials put the number of affected people at 50. Hospital sources said the water-borne disease hit 51 unions of the district, claiming at least six lives and affecting 2,000 others in last one month.

But officials said only two people died of the disease and 1,000 were affected. They identified the dead as Salma Begum of Kauhkhal and Jamila Khatun of Gabul thanas.

Meanwhile, two experts from ICDDR, B arrived here to investigate the outbreak of diarrhoea in the district.

The team will stay here for three days and visit the worst affected Mothbaria, Bhandaria, Kauhkhal and Sadar thanas. Locals alleged that they were not getting proper treatment although 51 medical teams are working in the areas round-the-clock as the number of doctors is inadequate to cope with the situation.

According to officials, 562 people died of diarrhoea and 36,962 were affected in the district in last 10 years.

Narcotics Deptt of Faridpur blamed for not cooperating with local admn

The Faridpur district administration has accused the local Narcotics Department of not cooperating with them in controlling drug abuse in the district, reports UNB.

This was disclosed at a special drug control meeting arranged by the district administration held with Deputy Commissioner AFM Abdul Haq in the chair on Wednesday.

The meeting was arranged following the last week's Gaibandha tragedy that left more than 60 people dead. The Deputy Commissioner was learnt to have told the meeting that the local Narcotics Control Department refused to provide them the list of authorised drunker of the district.

"I have failed to collect the list from the DG of Narcotics Control Department even after frequent requests over telephone," he alleged.

SP Mujibur Rahman also narrated the same experience at the meeting.

The meeting was informed that there are about 150 unauthorised dealers of wine in the district.

Officials of Narcotics Control Department, police, homeopath practitioners, political leaders and newsmen were present at the meeting.

FEMA workshop on 'election law reforms' today in Barisal

A day-long workshop on "Election law reform" organised by Fair Election Monitoring Alliance (FEMA) will be held at the BDS conference room in Barisal town today, reports BSS.

FEMA earlier completed its another three workshop on the same topic in Rajshahi, Khulna and Sylhet on March 21 and 28 and April 4, said a press release.

The theme of the workshop is to elicit public opinions on FEMA proposed draft recommendations to reform the existing electoral laws of the country with strengthening the Election Commission (EC) and appointing returning officers from judiciary.

Legislators, political leaders, lawyers and journalists are expected to participate in the workshop. FEMA chairperson Faquuddin Ahmed will also present on the occasion.

German envoy meets Speaker

The newly appointed Ambassador of Germany to Bangladesh, Uwe W. Schramm, called on Speaker Humayun Rasheed Chowdhury at his office Thursday, reports UNB.

During the meeting, they exchanged views on bilateral issues with special emphasis on cooperation between the parliaments of the two countries.

The Speaker informed the Ambassador live broadcast of parliament session by radio and TV has become very popular. In view of the situation, the government is contemplating to open a separate parliament TV channel so that the people can view the parliament session elaborately.

Jamaat holds rally in Narsingdi to protest beauty contest

Local Jamaat-e-Islami and Oikya Jote brought out separate processions in the Narsingdi town yesterday in protest of holding beauty contest in the country, reports UNB.

After the processions, Jamaat-e-Islami held a rally at bus stand premises and Oikya Jote at Bajir crossing.

The protesters sought the government's intervention to stop holding the beauty contest.

Obituary

Jamal Uddin Ahmed, a senior officer of National Bank Ltd died at PG Hospital in the city on Thursday following a brain tumor. He was 42.

He left behind his wife, a son, brother & sisters and a host of relatives & well-wishers. The officers & executives of the bank expressed their deep shock & pray for eternal peace of the departed soul, says a press release.

Number of drug addicts on rise

Drug sellers in seven thanas of Manikganj, including Savar and Dhamrai of Dhaka, are doing a perky business as the number of addicts has recently marked an unusual increase, reports UNB.

According to local people of Savar, a group of derailed youths after drinking alcohol resort to revelry on streets, making the movement of pedestrians, particularly that of the women, insecure.

Homemade wine is openly being sold at different homeo pharmacies in the thanas. Some sweetmeat shops in Manikganj Sadar are also allegedly selling homemade wine as the law-enforcing agency is keeping blind eyes to them.
