Bagmara-Daldalia canal needs reexcavation



RAJSHAHI, Apr 28: Thousands of farmers of Belpukuria and Bhalukgazi unions under Puthia thana are being deprived of additional production of crops due to silts in Bagmara-Daldalia canal.

The canal starts from the Padma river and flowing through many areas of Charghat and Puthia thanas falls into the Daldalia Beel. This canal was once used for irrigation, but it has remained derelict for many years. In early nineties, some portions of the canal was reexcavated, but the programme was not continued.

A programme on reexcavation of the canal was again undertaken by Water Development Board in 1996. About seven kilometers in Belpukuria union was excavated. But the programme was again suspended.

Local people said that the canal could be used for irrigation if only about three kilometer area upto Nandanpur Bridge from Bagmara-Daldalia point was reexcavated. Production of crops would increase two times by providing irrigation into the land on both sides of the canal.

Cruelty to woman 2 awarded 10-yr RI

MAGURA, Apr 28: Two persons have been awarded 10 years' Rigorous Imprisonment (RI) with a fine of Tk 1000, in default, to suffer another one month imprisonment for cruelty to a woman.

The convicted persons are: Abul Molla and Ujir Mondol of village Arpara under Madhukhal in Faridpur district.

Md A Hai, District and Sessions Judge of Magura delivered the judgement after conducting the trial.

The prosecution story in brief is, the convicted persons brought Nazma Khatun, daughter of Golapi Khatun of village Arpara in Madhukhal of Faridpur district from her grand-father's house at Sabol village Gacha in Sripur thana giving false news of her father's illness. When she was on way to her grand-father's house they fed her sweets and she became unconscious.

Local people recovered her from Meherpur and handed over to the local chairman. Golapi Khatun filed a case against the convicted persons with Sripur police.

2 killed in clashes over land

SHERPUR, Apr 28: Two persons were killed and several others injured in separate clashes here on April 20.

Dispute over plot of land in the sadar thana was the cause of clashes.

Jamila Khatun, 45, wife of Hasmat Ali of village Dhalakanda had a quarrel with her rival over possession of land. At one stage her rival hit her with a rod. As a result Jamila died on the spot at around 10 am.

Another clash occurred at Sherchar of Losmanpur union. Md Nizamuddin Ahmed, 45, died on the spot on same day.

Witnesses said he also picked up a quarrel over possession of land. At one stage his rivals hit him with a spade. Nizam died on the spot. All the injured were treated locally. Both the bodies were sent to morgue for postmortem.

Two separate cases have been filed with the sadar police station.

Separate incidents claim 4 in Gopalganj

GOPALGANJ, Apr 28: Four persons were killed and 8 others injured in two separate incidents here on Wednesday morning.

A loaded truck was unloading soil near the town by-pass road at Bederam in the sadar thana. At one stage 11,000 volt electric wire fell on the truck. The truck became electrified.

As a result three workers of the truck including the driver were killed and 8 other persons injured, 2 of them seriously.

The victims were identified and they are driver Rejaul Islam, 40, Kubbat Gazi, 20, and Abul Khan, 35. Injured persons are Esharat, 40, and Badar Ali, 28. Abu Musa Mohammad Fakrul Islam Khan, SP, Gopalganj visited the spot at noon on the day.

A case has been registered with Gopalganj thana.

In another incident, a boy named Bipul Biswas, 12, was killed by crushing under wheels of a running tempo. The boy was crossing the road at village Bandhabari on Gopalganj-Kotalipara road on Wednesday morning. The truck was going to Kotalipara from Magbari.

A case has been registered with Kotalipara police station.

Another rick loaded truck was coming towards the opposite direction. Suddenly it hit the other truck causing instantaneous death of three persons. All the three victims were repairing the other truck. Police seized both the trucks.
