Water Resources Minister tells BSS
Two projects taken up to ensure optimal use of Ganges water

The government has taken up two priority projects — Goral river excavation and updating pre-feasibility studies of the Ganges Barrage — to ensure optimal use of the Ganges water and save 40 million people of the country's south eastern region from severe environmental degradation caused by the desertification, Water Resources Minister Abdur Razzak told BSS yesterday.

He said the 30-million US dollar Goral Excavation Pilot Project is expected to be launched sometime in the month of September next to start capital dredging of the Goral offtake and its 30-kilometer-long channel. Updating the pre-feasibility studies to identify the areas of feasibility study and economic assessment will be completed by June this year, the sources added.

The Goral Excavation Project is part of the government's proposed 250 million US dollar "Goral River Restoration Project," in which the World Bank is expected to provide major

portion of the fund. Of the 30-million US dollar Goral Excavation Project, the Netherlands and Belgium governments will provide 20 million dollars and 5 million dollars as grant respectively while Bangladesh will provide the remaining 5 million dollars.

Following his confessional statement, made on April 22, police detectives yesterday seized Modarabad Savings Certificates and Fixed Deposit Receipts worth about Tk 60 lakh from his residence. He was placed on one day's remand on April 22, a police press release said.

Sirajul was arrested by Motijheel police after Nurul Amin, a senior vice president of the bank, filed a case with Motijheel thana on April 3 accusing him of misappropriating the money through fake voucher.


