Narsingdi town dwellers being deprived of civic amenities

NARSINGDI, May 4: Narsingdi Pourashava is beset with manifold problems including shortage of accommodation, bad roads, lack of drainage system and unhygienic atmosphere causing untold sufferings to the dwellers, reports UNB. Narsingdi thana was upgraded to a sub-division in 1977 and then to a district in 1984. But instead of its upgradation twice in seven years the civic amenities could not be increased comparatively. Dwellers here have been deprived of housing facilities as the House Building Finance Corporation has stopped providing loan since the last few years. Deploable condition of roads in the town is creating problems to the people. Breaches and potholes have developed at many points of the roads causing frequent accidents. Besides, traffic jam is a regular feature here as the roads are too narrow. An important portion of the main road went under illegal occupants. Rising number of rickshaws have increased the problems of pedestrians. Rickshaw pullers do not abide by the rules on the streets.

Meanwhile, the number of drug addicted people is rising here day by day. Different drugs are being sold in the town openly giving rise to anti-social activities. There is no proper drainage system in the town. Most of the times, the drains are overflowed. Garbage are dumped on the road sides turning the town into safe breeding centre of mosquito. Moreover there is no public toilet in the pourashava. Besides, stale foods are being sold in hotels and restaurants at random and many customers are suffering from various intestinal diseases.

Feud between 2 factions of BCL at IU intensifies

KUSHTIA, May 4: Feud between the factions of Bangladesh Chhatra League (S-P) at Islamic University (IU) has intensified with the announcement of two rival committees. The outgoing BCL President of IU unit on Sunday in a press conference here announced a new committee with Mir Mursheer Rahman as its President and M Abdul Khaleque as General Secretary. Addressing the press conference, BCL leaders said a proposal was sent to the central committee for the approval of the new committee. Earlier on March 30, former BCL President of the unit Shahjahan Alam Shaju, now Joint Secretary to the central committee, announced another committee with Zahurul Islam Milton and Abdul Hannan as President and General Secretary respectively. Tension is high on the campus as the rival groups are holding processions and rallies.

2 doctors arrested for possessing revolver, phensidyl

RAJSHAHI, May 4: Police arrested two junior doctors and recovered a revolver loaded with six round of bullets. A total of 10 bottles of phensidyl were also recovered at Katakali Market in the suburb. Motihar police said, Mohammad Qamruzzaman (Polash) and Biplob Ranzan Kumar Pal who have completed their internship training from Rajshahi and Dhaka Medical College Hospitals respectively, were challenged when they were going to the city by a rickshaw. Police searched them and recovered a revolver with six rounds of ammunition and 10 bottles of phensidyl. A case was filed in this connection.

From Our Correspondent FARIDPUR, May 4: Mohammad Samad, Assistant Director of Family Planning Department, Shariatpur died of massive heart attack recently. He was 53. According to family planning office source, late Samad had a stroke when he was on way to the office. He was immediately rushed to Faridpur Medical College Hospital where the attending doctors declared him dead. After *namaj-e-zanaja* he was buried at Alipur grave yard. He left behind his widow, one son, one daughter and a host of well-wishers to mourn his death.
