

National cricket championship Dinajpur, Khulna look strong

Dinajpur took a first innings lead over Rajshahi while Khulna put up a fighting against Faridpur on the first day of their three-day final encounter of the 24th national cricket championship yesterday. If drawn, matches will be decided on the basis of first innings lead.

In the Thakurgaon Zone final, Dinajpur were 222 for six at stumps on the first day in reply to Rajshahi's modest total of 200 all out.

At Sakthira, Khulna piled up a fighting total of 289 for nine in 100 overs when the stumps were drawn for the day. Paltu scored highest 73 runs for the port city outfit followed by two half centuries from Mithu (60) and Salahuddin (52).

Tuhin, unbeaten on 53, will resume the Khulna innings today with the hope of adding as many runs as possible to their overnight total before Faridpur

begin their chase, which already looks difficult. Among the Faridpur bowlers, right-arm seamer Ashfaq Ali, who plays for Abahani in the Dhaka cricket, captured four wickets for 67 runs, while discarded national medium-pace Sajal Chowdhury took two wickets for 46 runs.

Away in the Dhaka Zone semi-finals, Comilla were in a commanding position against Gazipur while Mymensingh piled up a huge total against Manikganj on the first day of their two-day affairs.


At the Bangabandhu National Stadium, Comilla were 95 for no loss in reply to a paltu Gazipur total of 149 all out in 70.1 overs. Anis, unbeaten on a dazzling 55 along with his opening partner Javed (28 not out), will resume the innings today with Comilla needing another 55 runs for a berth in the final.

At the Dhanmondi Cricket Stadium, Mymensingh scored 310 before being all out in 78 overs. Fahim Muntasir, a member of the national youth team, scored highest 64 runs for Mymensingh. Mahabubur Rahman Selim made 48 and opener Harun-ur Rashid hammered a quick-fire 40. Manikganj, needing over three runs per over, will begin their chase today.

Over at Bogra, Kakon hammered a brilliant 113 to help Sakthira amass a commanding total of 292 for nine in their share of 80 overs against Chapainawabganj.

Kakon apart, Prince scored a polished 54 and middle-order batsman Feroze fell one short of what would have been a deserting half-century.

For Chapainawabganj, who will begin their pursuit today, Yamin and Sumon al-Sharif, who have taken 11 and 10 wickets respectively, will be the main threat.

Cronje the lousy loser



CAPE TOWN, May 10 (Reuters): Michael Atherton's demise as England captain has left South Africa skipper Hansie Cronje as the second longest serving current Test leader after Sri Lanka's indefatigable Arjuna Ranatunga.

By the end of South Africa's five-test tour of England, Cronje will have completed four years and 36 Tests in charge.

With the country being violently contorted by the machinations and introspection within rugby, cricket remains largely popular and positive, with Cronje filling the position of sporting ambassador vacated by the desperately missed World Cup-winning Francois Pienaar.


If Cronje remains fit for the whole tour he will have missed just one international — Test or one-day — in all his time in charge. Good fortune with injuries has played virtually no part at all in that sequence.

The teeth-grinding determination that characterises his approach to the game is a direct inheritance from his predecessor Kepler Wessels, who captained South Africa in England four years ago.

Cronje has subsequently gone through the pain barrier on several occasions but obstinately refuses to succumb or even admit to injuries.

The downside to such unbridled passion is obvious. "I'm a very bad loser. I'm a good winner, but I'm really a terrible loser," Cronje admits.

His disappointments have manifested themselves in bouts of sulky brooding and poor communication, but generally his demand for his popularity has become brighter and his popularity greater the longer his reign has progressed.

When the match ended 90 minutes later, Cronje led his team from the field and thrust his souvenir stump through the umpires' dressing room door.

It would have guaranteed the end of many captaincy careers. But he received an extraordinary show of support from United Cricket Board of South Africa (UCBSA) managing director Ali Bacher. His intervention led the country to regard Cronje's action virtually as a badge of honour.

The episode was initially denied, then admitted to, with the culprit remaining anonymous. Finally Cronje was named with Bacher explaining

it was an "instinctive reaction" and that Cronje was unaware it was the door of the umpires' room.

Wessel Johannes Cronje, 28, appears to have the job as South Africa's captain for as long as he wants it. Despite difficulties against fast, short-pitched bowling, his ability at the top level is rarely questioned. He is a good Test player and a great one-day player.

But in South Africa's unique socio-political climate, it is his ambassadorial, charitable and unifying skills that make him so popular — and seemingly indispensable. South Africa needs Cronje's humanitarianism as much as his runs, wickets and cricketing brain.

Having tasted bitter defeat and disappointment in Australia, Cronje arrives in England with an altered perspective and changed priorities. Not for a second does he want victory less than before, but he has learnt the hard way how crippling is over-anxiety.

South Africa wanted to win too much in Australia and Cronje was responsible for fueling a raging desire. This time he is going to try to win with a smile, and to keep his souvenir stumps to himself if he does not.

Hingis rejoices in Rome

ROME, May 10: Top-ranked Martina Hingis overcame up-coming star Venus Williams in three sets Sunday to win the Italian Open in a match showcasing the hottest rivalry on the women's Tour, reports AP.

Hingis won 6-3, 2-6, 6-3, in just under two hours to capture her fourth title of the year.

The two players each 17, have been ripping up the Tour this year. The second round brought up their record up to 30-3, with two of the losses at the hands of the American.

German Open Costa's

HAMBURG, May 10: Unseeded Albert Costa won the German Open on Sunday when his exhausted Spanish rival Alex Corretja quit in the third set on a sweltering day, reports AP.

Corretja had fought through four marathon and tough three-set matches in three days, while Costa had to play only three games in Saturday's semifinals when his opponent Karol Kucera also retired, with foot blisters.

Costa, ranked No 26 in the world, encountered some resistance from sixth-seeded Corretja only in the first set and was up 6-2, 6-0, 1-0 when Corretja retired.

Latif to attend Lord's meet

Rashid Latif will represent Pakistan at the annual meeting of the International Cricket Council (ICC) Test captains at Lord's on May 18, according to a report of The Dawn newspaper.

Latif is already in England on vacations. The chief executive of the Pakistan Cricket Board (PCB), Majid Khan, said Latif was informed of the assignment last week.

Majid Khan, pointed out that Rashid Latif had been assigned to attend the meeting because he was the last Pakistan captain.

"Latif skipped Pakistan in the last series against Zimbabwe. Until another captain is made, Latif is the captain."

"His appearance in the captains conference doesn't mean that he will be the captain in the coming season," he clarified.

Interestingly, the inaugural meeting held last year was participated by Wasim Akram though Ramiz Raja had led Pakistan in the final series of the previous season against Sri Lanka.

All the captains of the nine Test playing countries will discuss various issues of the game and then a final report is prepared to be submitted to the game's governing body, the ICC. The ICC then considers what changes are to be made immediately. However, no significant changes were made last season after the inaugural meeting.

Lothar vows to be Vogtswise



BONN, May 10 (Reuters): Veteran of four World Cups Lothar Matthäus has promised he will show the enthusiasm of a teenager if German Coach Bert Vogts decides to take him to his fifth next month.

"If Bert calls me, I will be just as ambitious as when I started my international career 16 years ago," the 37-year-old Bayern Munich libero told German television ZDF late on Saturday.


Vogts, expected to announce his 22-man squad on Monday, has been under pressure to recall Germany's most capped player ever since Olaf Thon damaged ligaments in his right ankle last month.

Thon, who became Vogts' first choice for the libero slot after Matthias Sammer underwent career-threatening surgery on his left knee last October, said he should be fit in time for the World Cup starting on June 10. Sammer has already said he will not be able to make it.

"Naturally, I would be proud to play in my fifth World Cup final," said Matthäus, who captained Germany to victory in the 1990 World Cup and earned the last of his record 122 caps in December 1994. "I'm as impatient as an 18-year-old but I will respect Bert's decision, whatever it is."

Vogts said he had talked to Matthäus but gave no indication on what his final decision would be.

Juergen Klinsmann, who fell

out badly with Matthäus when they were both at Bayern Munich, said on Thursday he had talked to Vogts about it, telling him he would not object to the libero's return.

"We had a talk about it last week and I said clearly it was his (Vogts') decision, he's responsible for it and whatever he decides will be respected by the team, by every player," the Tottenham striker said.

The 35-year-old Klinsmann, who will retire from international football after the World Cup, will be in the squad but is not at all certain of a place in the first choice team.

Klinsmann faces a strong challenge from fellow strikers Oliver Bierhoff, Ulf Kirsten and Olaf Marschall, who have all enjoyed brilliant seasons.

Bayern Munich midfielder Mario Basler said on Friday he feared he might not be picked because he had not been asked to pass a mandatory medical check.

"I was wondering if they would ask me to go," said Basler, referring to Thursday's medical test in Munich.

"Those who will not go to the World Cup don't have to go (to the test)," he added.

Basler, 29, has been hampered by injury all season and is currently nursing damaged ligaments on his left knee.

"I'll wait until Monday and if I'm not in I'll go on holiday," he said.

Vogts is expected to rely on a handful of players who have seen it all before like defenders Juergen Kohler and Thomas Helmer or midfielders Andreas Möller and Thomas Hässler.

There should be a few new names too such as Bayern defender Dietmar Hamann and defensive midfielder Jens Jeremies, who plays for Munich's other club, TSV 1860 Munich.

Vogts has already said he would take three goalkeepers to France. First choice Andreas Koeppke, who plays for Olympique Marseille, should be accompanied by Bayern's Oliver Khan and Schalke 04's Jens Lehmann.

West opened 1 Spade and Aminullah sitting North doubled and East bid 2 Spades and partner bid 3 Diamond. With a minimum hand, West passed. North bid 4-carder Heart suit. With void in opponents' suit, partner smelled slam. Via a cue bid, South ambitiously reached six Hearts. East, who was rather an inexperienced player did not open Ace of Club as he was holding AQ of the suit. A Spade was led, and Aminullah merrily made his 6 Hearts doubled.
