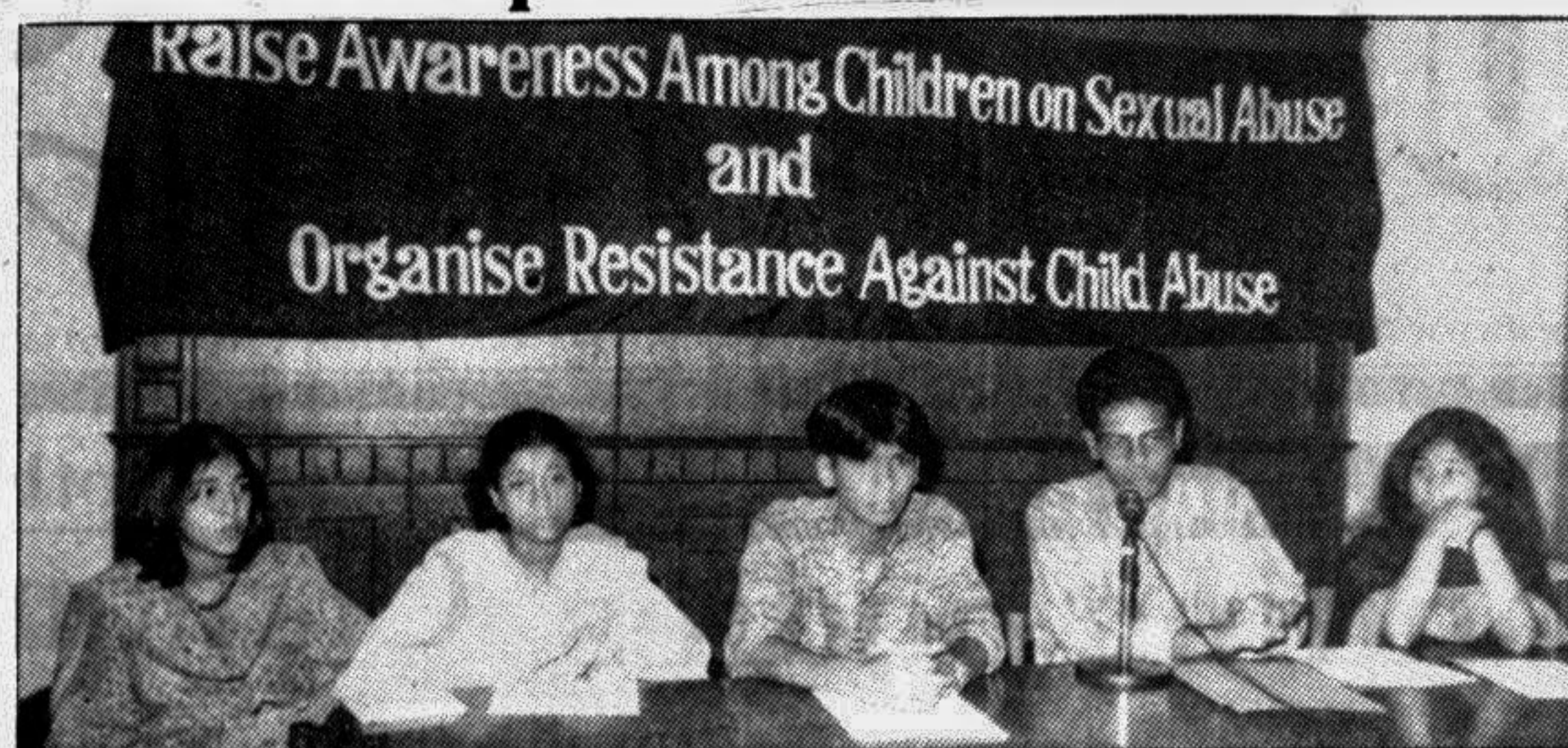

Call for resistance against child abuse

Schools students in the city yesterday demanded raising awareness among children on sexual abuse and called for resistance against child abuse.

They also called for restructuring and reform of the entire system of bringing criminals to justice.

Addressing a press conference at the National Press Club VIP Lounge yesterday evening, the students said that the killing of Shazneen in her own bedroom, made it clear that nobody was safe and secure anywhere.

All the participants on the press conference were the students of class nine and were the close friends of late Shazneen who studied at the Sunbeams and the Scholastica School.

The students alleged that the process of free fair and proper investigations of criminal cases are hampered in many ways. They said time has come for the government to clearly demonstrate that it is ready to ensure exemplary punishment against those who commit atrocious crimes as well as the manipulators.

The students said, "We feel that our government, our law enforcing agencies, and our elders have failed to provide us with minimum security."

Explaining their objectives

In holding the press conference, the students said "It is this feeling of insecurity and vulnerability which brought us, the students, together to raise our voice and demand concrete action from concerned quarters." "We are here today not under the banner of organisation, nor are we inspired by any NGO or political party; we represent here, our own interest and want to express our own concern," they said.

Rashed Shabab of the Sunbeams School read out a written statement at the press conference while five other students from the Scholastica and Sunbeams School replied to various queries of the journalists.

A number of teachers and guardians were also present at the press conference.

Expressing their grave concern regarding the recent increase of heinous crimes, the students said, "We all know that in recent times gross abuses of women and children have increased alarmingly. Murder of women in custody, rape of minor girls inside court premises, abduction of housewife in market place in broad day light make every citizen feel extremely insecure and vulnerable."

Pointing to the long process of trial and investigation to the

cases concerning the crimes against women and children, the students said, "Over the years most of the crimes committed against women and children, or for that matter any innocent citizen went largely unattended from what we hear, independent. Fair and proper investigations are hampered in many ways and it appears that somehow, those who commit crimes, have more access to the system than the victim."

Replying to another question, Jeeshia Sarwar of Scholastica School said that the killing of our friend Shazneen has struck us with so much gravity that we have been compelled to come out in protest of such barbarous killings and we pledge so that this becomes the end of it.

Anan Rahman, Rashed Shabab and Sabir Zahir of the Sunbeams School, and Jeeshia Sarwar, Amirah Ahmed and Sabah Rabbi of the Scholastica School answered to various queries of the journalists at the press conference. A teacher of the Scholastica School Farida Moli and Dr. Tasneem Siddique, an associate professor of Political Science at Dhaka University also spoke on the occasion representing the guardians.

Begum Razia Banu, Ex-MP, grand daughter of Sher-E-Bangla A.K.Fazlul Haque and wife of Late Syed Mahbubur Rahman, Ex-Secretary of parliament, died of heart attack at 8-30 P.M. on Sunday, May 10, 1998. She was buried at Banani Graveyard on Monday. Qulkhwan of Late Razia Banu will be held after Asr Prayers on Thursday, May 14 at Rose Villa Apartments, Road No : 6, Bldg No : 14, Gulshan-1. Friends and relations are cordially requested to attend.
