The second phase of the 16th national schools cricket Dhaka Zonal qualifying round begins this morning with four matches scheduled at different venues in the capital.

Ten group champions from the first phase are taking part in this knock-out phase from which four semifinalists will qualify for the final round.

On the opening day of the five-day long second phase. Wills Little Flower will take on Shafiuddin Academy at the Mirpur Outer Stadium while Motifheel Govt High School will face Bangladesh Krira Shikkha Protisthan (BKSP) at the nearby City Club ground. The winners of these two matches will qualify for the May 16 semifinals.

In the other two matches, Pallabi MI Academy will meet Udayan Bidyalaya at the Mahakhali T&T ground while Loreto will play against Rahmatullah Model Academy at the Uttara Friend's Club ground.

The winners of the Pallabi-Udayan match will face Scholastica in the quarterfinal on May 14 at the City Club ground while the other winners will meet Maple Leaf in the remaining quarterfinal on May 15 at the T&T ground.

The final will be held at the Dhaka Stadium on May 17.

Cronje not being complacent



The South Africans arrived in England earlier in the day to take on a team which has suffered a run of Test reverses in the past few years, sandwiching just one series victory in New Zealand in 1997 between defeats by Pakistan, Australia and West Indies and a meagre draw with Zimbabwe.

But Cronje, who led his country to a 1-0 Test series victory over England in South Africa in 1995/96, cautioned against excessive south African optimism.

"It would be very foolish to write off England playing at home," Cronje told a news conference at English cricket's headquarters at Lord's.

South Africa, who begin their first tour match against Worcestershire on Thursday. play three one-day internationals this month before contesting five Tests and concluding their tour with a triangular tournament against England and Sri Lanka.

Beyond that lies a Test series against West Indies and the limited-over World Cup but, for now, Cronje just wants to concentrate on the task against England.

"For us the main target, and for me as captain, is to try and win the Test series," he said. "But we've also got the West Cup Winners' Cup final today



Earlier, Odumbe had raised allegations against the selectors for discriminating him in favour of an Asian player like Karim.

Vogts hoping against hope?



BONN, May 12 (Reuters): Juergen Klinsmann will retain the captain's armband at

the World Cup finals, German coach Berti Vogts said on Monday after recalling veteran Lothar Matthaeus into his squad

"Juergen Klinsmann is and will remain the Germany captain," Vogts said.

Bayern Munich libero Matthaeus captained Germany to victory in the 1990 World Cup while Klinsmann led his country in their triumphant Euro '96 campaign.

Vogts said he was convinced that the two, who squabbled when they played together at Bayern Munich, would get on

It's clear that Lothar and him (Klinsmann) are not the best of friends," Vogts said. "But the most important thing is for the team to be successful. I told both of them that and they understood."

The 37-year-old Matthaeus, who earned the last of his record 122 caps in December 1994, will play in his fifth World Cup finals after 1982, 1986, 1990 and 1994.

Vogts had been under pressure to recall Matthaeus since Olaf Thon damaged ligaments in his right ankle last month.

Thon, who became Vogts' first choice for the libero slot after Matthias Sammer underwent career-threatening knee surgery last October, said he should be fit in time for the finals, and is also in the squad.

"With Matthias Sammer's injury and Olaf Thon's problems. I had to ask myself what would happen if Thon was not fit," Vogts said. "It was too risky

Juergen quits Spurs on a sour note

LONDON, May 12: Tottenham striker Juergen Klinsmann has fired a farewell broadside at coach Christian Gross and said that a working relationship with the Swiss boss was "almost impossible," reports Reuters.

In an interview to be screened on the BBC on Monday. Klinsmann said that Gross reneged on the agreement made between the two men when the German captain returned last December.

"He told me we would do things together, then I realised he didn't want to - he just wanted to do it his own way." said Klinsmann.

"He told me to keep opinion to myself. he more or less told me to shut up."

Klinsmann said he was used to exchanging opinions with his managers and said that Germany boss Berti Vogts encouraged such dialogue. "I'm in a position where

people expect things from me. I have this job in the German national team - Vogts is always happy for people to express their opinions.
