#### Orphan child violated

HABIGANJ. May 13: An orphan girl child was violated by a young man of Gajnaipur in Nabiganj thana here on Friday, reports UNB.

Family sources said, the victim Shamsi, 5, while playing in a nearby field with another two babies the culprit co-villager, Rangu Mian took her to a bush near Quazi Bari and raped her. The cruel rapist also tried to strangle her to death with the help of a creeper. The victim returning to her house in a bleeding condition narrated the incident to her grandmother. She then took her to a local quack and later she was admitted to Habiganj Sadar Hospital. Shamsi lost her father when she was one year old and her mother again married another man only two weeks before the day of the incident.

#### Smuggling thru' Benapole on rise

BENAPOLE, May 13: Smuggling through Benapole checkpost has reportedly marked an increase due to inaction of the law enforcing agencies, reports UNB.

According to reports everyday 7-8 Indian youths, believed to be the members of an international gang of racketeers, roam around the check-post under the nose of administration. The bootleggers, who have links with some stall owners in the area, smuggle various items, including gold and dollars, into India from Bangladesh. The law enforcing agencies were said to have given blind eyes to the smugglers.

#### Meeting foiled by miscreants

TANGAIL, May 13: A group of miscreants foiled a meeting of teachers and student leaders on the admission procedures of new comers at Sadat University College here on Sunday night, reports UNB.

The terrorists raided the meeting room as the college authority refused to admit the admission seekers of first year honours classes as per their terms. The miscreants exploded crackers and damaged furniture of the meeting room creating a reign of terror on the campus.

The teachers said they were forced to flee the campus for fear of life. Later they came to district headquarters for holding talks with the DC and SP in this regard, but they said instead of hearing them in person both the officials asked them to come with a written complaint.

#### Soil fertility declining

NARSINGDI, May 13: Fertility of soil in the district is declining rapidly due to indiscriminate use of chemical fertilisers, affecting foodgrain output, reports UNB.

According to experts, farmers cultivate paddy on the same field year after year and use chemical fertilisers instead of organic ones to boost production whih ultimately affect the soil fertility.

They said the growers now cannot use cowdung, water-hyacinth and other wastes on crop lands as they use those as combustible materials, making the soil harder. According to the farmers, they are being compelled to use cowdung as fuel instead of spreading it on land due to spiraling price of fire-woods.

#### 100 ringwells installed by PHED

BANDARBAN, May 13: The Public Health Engineering Department (PHED) has installed 100 ringwells in different thanas of Bandarban district under the rehabilitation programme, reports BSS.

Official sources said, the work for setting-up ringwells during the last 10 month, at a cost of Taka about 58 lakh has also been completed. During the last fiscal year PHED had also installed 360 tubewells and ringwells in seven thanas of Bandarban at a cost of Taka about two crore twenty-three lakh, the sources added.

#### 70,000 pry students facing problems

FENI. May 13: About 70,000 primary students have been facing problem to prosecute their studies as they are yet to get the sets of text books, reports UNB.

The district primary education department sources said there are a total of 611 primary schools and about 2.18 lakh students in the ongoing session. But they said they managed to supply books to only 1,48,669 students, and due to its shortage they could not supply the same to about 70,000 students. The students are facing enormous problems to continue their studies as about four months of the current session have already been elapsed.

## Bid to commit suicide foiled

SIRAJGANJ, May 13: Two youths allegedly attempted to commit suicide by taking insecticides Monday in separate incidents here for refusal of their guardians to get married with their beloved, reports UNB.

Police and hospital sources said one Nazrul Islam, 20, son of Fazlu Mia of Bara Chabila village of Ullapara thana took poison when his father refused to allow him to marry his fiancee He was rushed to the Sirajganj General Hospital in a critical condition. In another incident Manjela Khatun, 18, daughter of Hasen Ali of Ramgati in Sadar thana tried to commit suicide by taking poison after her father refused to allow her to marry her beloved. She was also admitted to the Sadar hospital in a critical condition.

# Seven awarded life-term for trafficking women, children

SATKHIRA, May 13: Seven persons including a woman were recently convicted and sentenced to suffer life-term imprisonment each on charge of trafficking of women, children or raping women.

The court also fined each Taka 5,000, indefault to suffer rigorous imprisonment (RI) for

one year more. The convicts are: Abdul Wahab and Abdus Sattar, both of village Maddhupur and Safiqul Islam of village Kandarpapur all under Manirampur thana and Abul Kashem of village Mominpur all under Jessore district, Khorshed and Latifa, wife of Khorshed both of village Bhadiali under Kalaroa thana in Satkhira district and Ali Hossain of village Paikgacha under Hoogly district in West Bengal, India.

The prosecution story, in brief, is that acting on a secret information police raided the

hired house of Khorshed at Muvarikati under Kalaroa thana and recovered Anowara, 18, and Firoza, 17, both of village Khanpur under Manirampur

thana of Jessore district. Police also arrested trafficker Abdul Wahab and after his (Wahab) confession, police rescued Rawshan Ara, 19, of Talbaria under the thana in Satkhira district, Shahida, 20, of village Mominpur and Basanti Rani, 21, of village Bakabarshi, both of Keshabpur thana and Fatema, 22, of village Mujgunni under Manirampur thana of Jessore district from a home at Bhadiali village under Kalaroa thana while they were being trafficked to India on November 9, 1996.
