

Italy 1990 World Cup

Paying the penalty

The best thing about Italia '90 was Pavarotti. His singing of excerpts from Pucini, beamed out live on giant TV screens during the opening ceremony, will be remembered long after what football was served up by the 24 teams, has been forgotten. This ailing competition, transmitted to countless millions around the world in a blaze of grandiose hype, was just about the worst imaginable advertisement for football. Some would say, it was the referees' repeatedly flourished red and yellow cards that provided most of the colour.

In soccer's sick showpiece, both semi-finals were decided on penalties, before a sterile final, with two Argentine players sent off, was decided by the only goal, a late West German penalty.

The only records broken in Italy were unwanted ones. A total of 164 yellow and 16 red cards displayed by referees meant that there was an average of over three bookings a match, with nearly one dismissal every three games.

Some of the most exciting football was played by Cameroon, the first African nation to reach the quarter-final of a World Cup. They approached their game with a refreshing naivety, but their propensity for cynically hacking opponents down in full flight does not bode well for their football.

World Cup 90 opened sensationally with defending champions Argentina going down to Cameroon. The Africans, despite their unbeaten performance in the 1982 World Cup, were given no hope, but they beat an unrecognizable Argentina 1-0, despite finishing up with nine men.

Hosts Italy were unimpres-

sive too. They actually played ereative, attacking football until they came near the goal. It needed strike from inspirational substitute "Toto" Schillaci in the 78th minute, four minutes after he went on, to beat thoroughly outplayed Austria in their first match. Vialli was one star who did enhance his reputation as Italy went on to win their three group matches. They were the only side not to concede a goal in the first round, although they struggled to beat the United States.

West Germany qualified with ease, and were top scorers in the first round with 10 goals. England muddled through once more. They got through by beating Egypt 1-0 in the only match not drawn. As it turned out Holland and Republic of Ireland joined England in the next round. Scotland in their seventh World Cup finals preserved their record of never getting past the first round. They even lost to Costa Rica 0-1.

Cameroon brought off a spectacular win against Colombia in the opening match of the second round. The lively Africans accounted for, perhaps, a craftier South American combination in which Valderrama was the centrepiece. The match went into extra-time after the teams had drawn 1-1. The final score stood

at 2-1 in favour of the Africans. Czechoslovakia had the best match against Costa Rica whom they beat by a comfortable margin of 4-1. England stopped

Belgium 1-0 after extra time. The Argentina-Yugoslavia tie needed penalty shootout as the teams finished 0-0 even after extra-time in the quarterfinals. England played out a match against

Cameroon. Platt put England ahead, before they found themselves in trouble 2-1 down with eight minutes to go. But Gascoigne drove them forward, and twice Linekar was brought down in the box, each time converting the spot-kick (3-2).



striker Tore Andre Flo. Captain Dennis Wise immediately fed him with a glorious pass and the Italian strode into the box and lashed a rising half-volley past helpless Austrian keeper Franz Wohlfahrt into the roof of the net. He has been on the field for 18 seconds.

"It was incredible for me. I could not control myself," Zola said, "One of the best moments

of my career. The single goal was enough for player-manager Gianluca Vialli's multinational side to earn the club their first European trophy since they beat Real Madrid 27 years ago in the same competition.

Vialli benched his fellow countryman for the final after Zola missed three games because of a groin injury that he sustained three weeks ago.


