Views of judges to be sought on changes in CPC

The parliamentary standing committee on Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Ministry will seek views of representatives of higher level of the judiciary shortly regarding the proposed amendments to the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908.

For the second consecutive day yesterday, the committee heard views of representatives of various bar associations in the country. Leaders of bar associations in Khulna, Barisal and Sylhet divisions supported the move to amend the CPC while giving their views before the committee, headed by Suranjit Sengupta.

On Tuesday, bar associations in Dhaka, Chittagong and Rajshahi divisions gave similar views before the committee that sat at Committee Room 1 of the Sangsad Bhaban.

Law Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Minister Abdul Matin Khasru piloted the proposed bill — Code of Civil Procedure (Amendment) Bill, 1997 — last year to lessen the burden of 26,000 revision cases now lying with the High Court Division.

The Colombo SAARC summit was originally scheduled to be held from July 20 to 22.

"Our Foreign Minister Lakhsman Kadirgamar would be able to announce the new dates officially after final confirmation was received from all countries," he added.

According to the SAARC charter, all members have to give their consent to policy decisions, including summit dates.

The Sri Lankan High Commissioner expressed the hope that the forthcoming SAARC summit would contribute to "relaxing the atmosphere" in the Subcontinent and enable member-states to carry forward its agenda for greater economic cooperation.

S B Autogoda said Sri Lanka had excellent relations with all the SAARC states. His country was particularly happy that it was given the opportunity to host the 10th summit after Nepal and Pakistan agreed to pass over the important occasion to Sri Lanka.

The ninth SAARC summit was held in Male, capital of the Maldives, from May 12 to 14 last year.

Ensure security of female & child patients in hospitals: SNS

Sammilita Nari Samaj (SNS) has demanded of the Health Ministry to take immediate steps to ensure security of female and child patients and their attendants at hospitals and clinics in the country.

It expressed deep concern at the 'state of insecurity' at clinics and hospitals.

Besides, an amendment in the definition of 'pauper' is proposed in the bill, enhancing the ceiling of property possessed by a pauper to Tk 10,000 from Tk 100.

Bar association's representatives from Khulna, Moulvibazar, Pirojpur, Jhalkathi, Kushtia, Meherpur, Magura, Barguna, Satkhira and Patuakhali appeared before the committee yesterday to give their views while those from Noakhali Bar Association, who had missed their Tuesday's schedule also turned up yesterday.

Supporting the proposed amendments to the CPC, the representatives also gave some suggestions. Some of them proposed repeal of all 'black laws' including the Special Powers Act and Vested Property Act and amendment to Contempt of Court law.

Responsible for their proposals, Abdul Matin Khasru said that he would write letters to all bar associations in 10 days seeking their views in this regard.

Summing up the hearing programme for the day, Suranjit Sengupta said, there was no alternative to speedy trial.

Later, talking to The Daily Star, Sengupta said, boundless indiscipline, complexities, corruption and bribery were pushing the judicial system on the brink of collapse.

He said that after the two-day public hearing arranged for the lower level of the judiciary, "we'll now invite representatives of the Bar Council, Supreme Court Bar Association, Supreme Court judges and eminent jurists to give their views".
