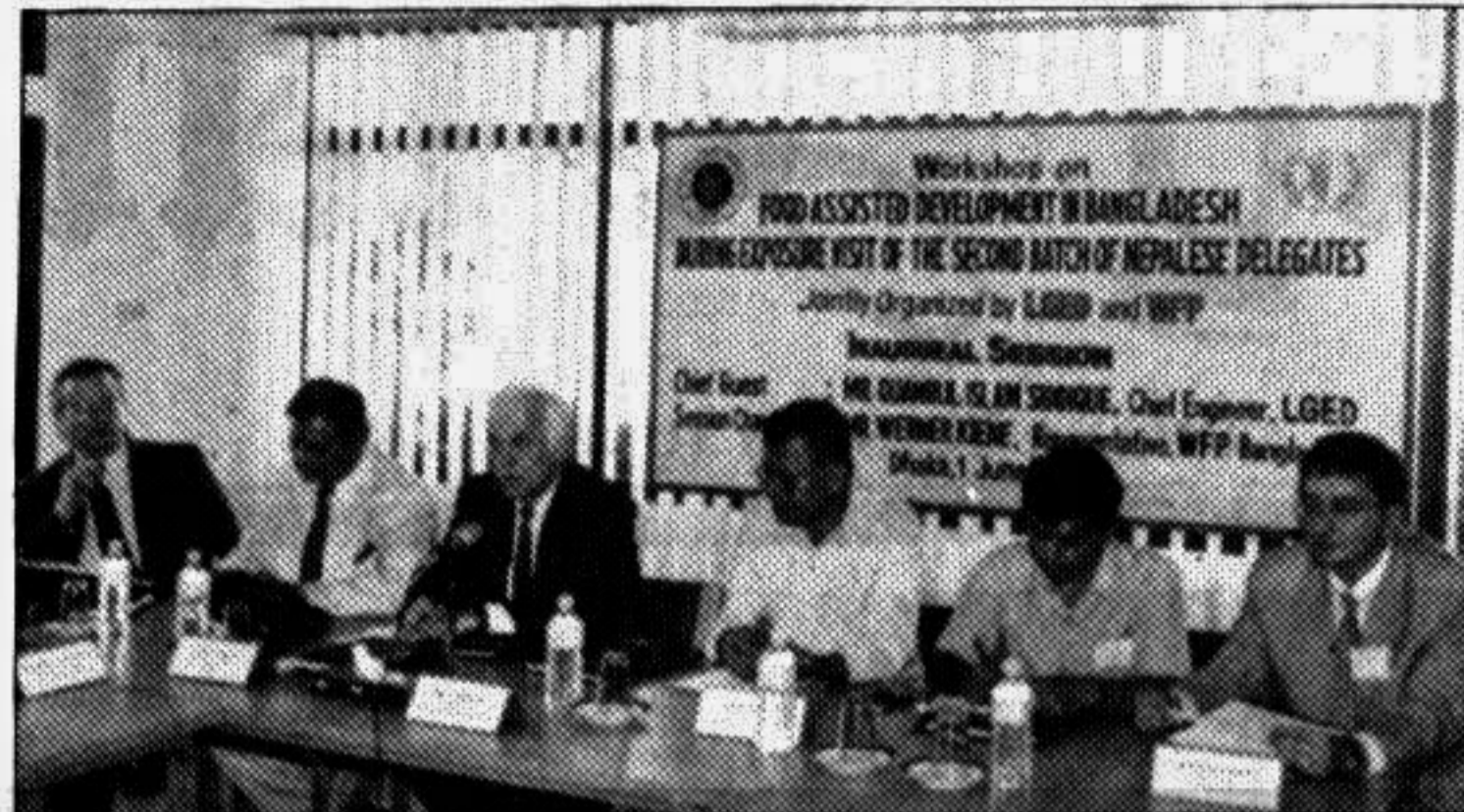

## Nepal has lot of things to learn from Bangladesh'

A day-long workshop marking the visit of a team from Nepal to food-assisted development programmes in Bangladesh concluded in the city yesterday with a call for sharing and exchanging experiences, reports BSS.

Jointly organised by Local Government Engineering Department (LGED) and World Food Programme (WFP), the workshop was held at the LGED Bhaban. Besides the 36-member team from Nepal, high officials of the LGED, Ministry of Food and WFP in Dhaka took part in the workshop.

The Nepalese envoy said Nepal being an agro-based economy, has a lot of things to learn from Bangladesh. Nepal can specially know how Bangladesh is developing its agriculture to feed the 12 crore people, he said.

Split into three sessions, the inauguration of the workshop was addressed by acting ambassador of Nepal to Bangladesh Dr Rambhakta PB Thakur, chief engineer of LGED Quamrul Islam Siddiqui, leader of the Nepalese team Dr Tana Goutam, WFP adviser in Bangladesh Bishow Parajuli, WFP representative Werner Keine and additional chief engineer of LGED Monowar Hossain Chowdhury.

Quamrul Islam Siddiqui gave a detailed picture of how infrastructural development in rural Bangladesh is taking place under local-level plan-

ning and with the active participation of the elected local government representatives and people.

He lauded the role of the WFP for its enormous contributions in carrying out the development projects in Bangladesh.

The LGED is implementing 31 rural infrastructure development projects under RD (Rural Development) and one sector with an annual outlay of over Taka 607 crore (135 million US dollars), he said. Of those projects, six are being implemented with food assistance from the WFP, while the rest are progressing with the help from donors and the Bangladesh government, he said.

Werner Keine spoke on the goal, major areas of collaboration and operation philosophy of WFP in Bangladesh. He said the WFP has mobilised food inputs of 4,50,000 tons for the year 1997-98 worth Taka 687 crore (135 million US dollar) through RD and VGD (vulnerable group feeding) channels to reach the 'poorest of the poor' in Bangladesh.

Additional chief engineers of LGED Rubaiyat Nurul Hassan and Monowar Hossain Chowdhury presented two papers on rural development strategy and food-assisted rural infrastructure development in Bangladesh in the plenary session-1.

Bishow Parajuli and programme officer of WFP M Younus Khan presented two papers in the concluding session.

Werner Keine presided over the inaugural and the concluding sessions, while LGED chief engineer Quamrul Islam Siddiqui chaired the plenary session-1.

## Menon warns govt against signing SOFA with US

Workers Party leader Rashed Khan Menon Sunday warned the government against signing any agreement that will allow entry of foreign troops in the country, reports UNB.

He said the Workers Party will build up a strong resistance on June 15 against the reported move of signing an agreement (SOFA) with USA.

Addressing a press conference Menon accused the government of patronising corruption and granting fresh bank loans to defaulters instead of taking action against them.

Menon was highly critical of the government for failure in all spheres of the economy and keeping up its election pledges to the nation.

He referred to the electricity, water and gas crises and high prices of essentials, deteriorating law and order which have increased the miseries of the people. He said instead of resolving the problem, the government is engaged in politicising the administration.

The Workers Party leader was also critical of the government for the reported move of raising secret police for suppressing and oppressing the people.

Menon was also critical of the opposition BNP for its failure to focus the national issues and oppose the rise of fundamentalists.

## Saudi parliamentary team leaves for home

The high-powered parliamentary delegation of *Majlis Ash Shura* of Saudi Arabia left here for home yesterday morning ending a 4-day visit to Bangladesh, reports UNB.

Speaker Humayun Rashid Chowdhury saw the delegation off at the airport.

The delegation, led by the president of Saudi *Majlis Ash Shura* Sheikh Mohammad Bin Ibrahim Bin Zubair, arrived in the city on May 28.

During the visit, the delegation members called on President Shahabuddin Ahmed, Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, Speaker Humayun Rashid Chowdhury and Foreign Minister Abdus Samad Azad.

## 450 illegal power connections disconnected

Dhaka Electricity Supply Authority (DESA) in a drive in Satarkul area in Gulshan thana yesterday disconnected 450 illegal power connections, reports UNB.

It also seized 175 kg of electric wire and detained a person in this connection. Thirteen cases were filed, according to an official handout.

## Gabali-Gulistan route to have 7 new double-deckers from June 8

Seven new double-deckers buses will be pressed into service on Gabali-Gulistan route of the city from June 8, reports UNB.

In the first phase, 42 buses, out of 200, will reach the capital soon under the double-decker procurement programme of Bangladesh Road Transport Corporation (BRTC), according to an official handout.

Of the 42 double-deckers, being procured at a cost of 105.14 million Indian rupee under an Indian state loan, two buses arrived in the city Friday while five more will be brought in by June 8.

The 85-seat double-deckers will take about 25 to 30 minutes to reach Gulistan from Gabali. Bus fare has been fixed at Tk eight per person for the route.

At present, 47 double-deckers are playing on different city routes.

## Admission into ILIS courses

Candidates seeking admission into the certificate and diploma courses of the Institute of Library and Information Science (ILIS) have been instructed to collect their application forms by June 14 and 18 for certificate course and diploma course respectively, according to a press release, reports BSS.

Run by the Library Association of Bangladesh, the office of the institute is located at the Central Public Library at Shahbagh and is open from 2 pm to 7 pm.

Qualification for certificate course is HSC and for diploma course is graduation with five points, the release said.

Admission test for certificate course will be held on June 19 and for diploma course June 26.

## English language teaching project launched

The English Language Teaching Improvement Project (ELTIP), a joint venture of the Bangladesh government and Department of International Development (DFID) of UK, was launched yesterday at the premises of the National Curriculum and Textbook Board, says a press release.

The project, managed by the British Council on behalf of the DFID, aims at improving the teaching of English at secondary schools through a process of curriculum and textbook development, examination reform and in-service teacher training in communicative language teaching, the release added.

Officials of the Ministry of Education and British High Commission in Dhaka were present during the launching ceremony.

## Tree plantation campaign to be launched June 15

The Forest Department will launch a nationwide tree plantation campaign and tree fair from June 15, reports BSS.

Under the directives of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina, who will formally launch the campaign, the department will work for materialising its objective of planting at least two trees (one fruit-bearing and one fine wood tree) in every house of the country, Conservator of Forests (Dhaka-central circle) AHM Monzurul Karim said.

The conservator said 1,83,275 destitute families have been involved in the social forestry programme.

## Body to conduct functioning of hospital formed

An eight-member committee headed by Telecommunications Minister Mohammad Nasim has been formed to conduct the overall functioning of the hospital constructed by Kuwaiti grants at Sector 6 at Uttara Model Town in the city, reports BSS.

An official handout issued yesterday this was decided at an inter-ministerial meeting held in the conference room of the Ministry of Works with Mohammad Nasim in the chair.
