

PARIS, June 3: It's a wonderful morning in Paris today. Perhaps the season has arrived when the

famous line from Charles Dickens can be borrowed: "It was the best of times." Only 11 days from now the French people will remember and celebrate the great Bastille Day on the 14th of June, the day of French Revolution.

On the 10th, the World Cup kicks-off in one of the most beautiful stadiums of the world - a reminder to French culture and aesthetics, a superb example of modern architecture.

The bustling Roland Garros will slip into silence for another year after an exciting fortnight of world class tennis. Indeed this is the best of times for France.



The Simple Dames champion will not be so simple anymore as she will receive 3624000 and runners-up 1812000 FF.
