Hick yet to give up hope

BIRMINGHAM, England, June 4 (Reuters): Statistically, Graeme Hick is one of the most impressive batsmen in cricket history.

At the age of 32, he is the second-youngest batsman to score 100 first class centuries and only Sir Donald Bradman and Denis Compton of the 24 men to compile a century of centuries have done so in fewer innings.

Yet Worcestershire's unassuming Zimbabwe-born batsman will not be among the England XI who meet South Africa in the first Test today. Opinion is divided on Hick's merits at international level.

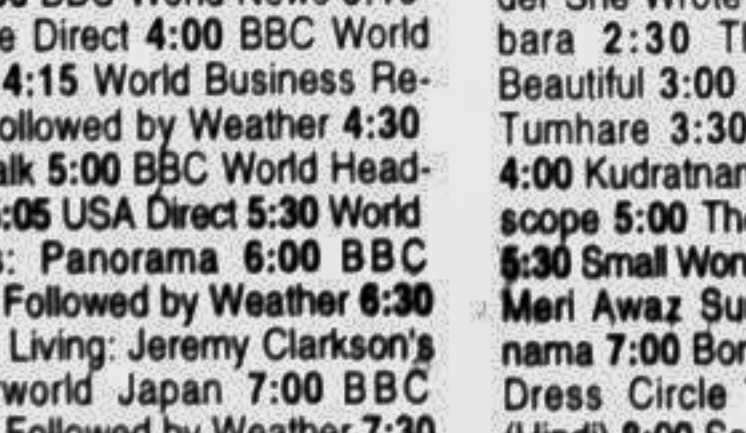
Only four of his centuries have been scored in 46 England appearances and the cruel tag of "hat track bully" coined by former New Zealand off-spinner John Bracewell has stuck.

Certainly, after his unhappy debut against the fearsome West Indies pace bowling in 1991, he has proved vulnerable at different times to the bouncer, yorker and googly.

His supporters say he has still averaged 36.10 in an unsuccessful England side and has three times been out in the 90s. Still the disparity between his Test average and his career average of 56.58 suggests he has yet to impose himself on the Test arena and time is now running out.

"I am not lacking any desire to play international cricket," Hick said after reaching his landmark against Sussex on Sunday.

"I've been batting well so far this season and if I keep doing that you can only hope you'll make the right people sit up and take notice.

again." Hick played his last Test two years ago after scoring only one 50 in his last 13 innings although he has since represented his adopted country in the one-day arena.

In New Zealand, six for an England XI, four for Zimbabwe and three for Queensland. Hick's 405 not out against Somerset at Taunton 10 years ago, remain the highest score in English cricket since Archie Maclaren's 424 for Lancashire also at Taunton, in 1895.

And in that same vintage summer of 1988 Hick plundered a memorable 172 against the West Indies to become only the ninth batsman ever to reach 1,000 runs before the end of May.

Fittingly his latest entry into the record books was in front of the Worcestershire supporters who have witnessed so many of his best innings.

"Worcester has become a very special place for me and if I could have chosen anywhere in the world to score my 100th hundred apart from in a Test match it would have been here at New Road," he said.

The moment of triumph was greeted by a standing ovation from the crowd of 2,000 and a glass of champagne brought to the wicket by Worcestershire president Tom Graveney, the former England batsman, who achieved the feat himself in 1964.

"The last 20 runs were tough to go through because the crowd were reacting to every run," Hick said, "the closer I got the more I was thinking I didn't want to waste the chance and have to go through it all again.

"So I was really relieved to scamper the last two runs."

Nat'l cricket N'ganj in semis

Sports Reporter Narayanan moved into the semifinals of the 24th national cricket championship with a 41-run win over Comilla at the Sylhet Stadium yesterday.

Batting first in a rain reduced 25-over-a-side affair, Narayanan scored 105 for eight with Mridul hammering highest 26. Among others, Zia scored 18 while Munna added 15 to the winners' credit.

In reply, Comilla were reeling at 64 for six when they refused to play after 20 overs' play citing bad light. But the umpires did not agree with the Comilla skipper and declared Narayanan as the winners.

Narayanan will now face last year's runners-up Biman in the second semifinal. The first semifinal, a three-day affair, between holders Chittagong and Rajshahi will begin at the same venue today.

Atherton hits hundred

Star Sport Monitor Mike Atherton hit an unbeaten hundred as England got off to a solid start on the opening day of the first Test against South Africa at Edgbaston yesterday.

The former England captain laced his innings of 103 not out with 12 fours to help the home side amass 249 for one when stumps were drawn for the day.

Atherton put up 179 runs for the first wicket with Mark Butcher, who scored 77 runs.

and Arantxa lead 7-2, including this match and on clay it was 3-0 in favour of Sanchez-Vicario.

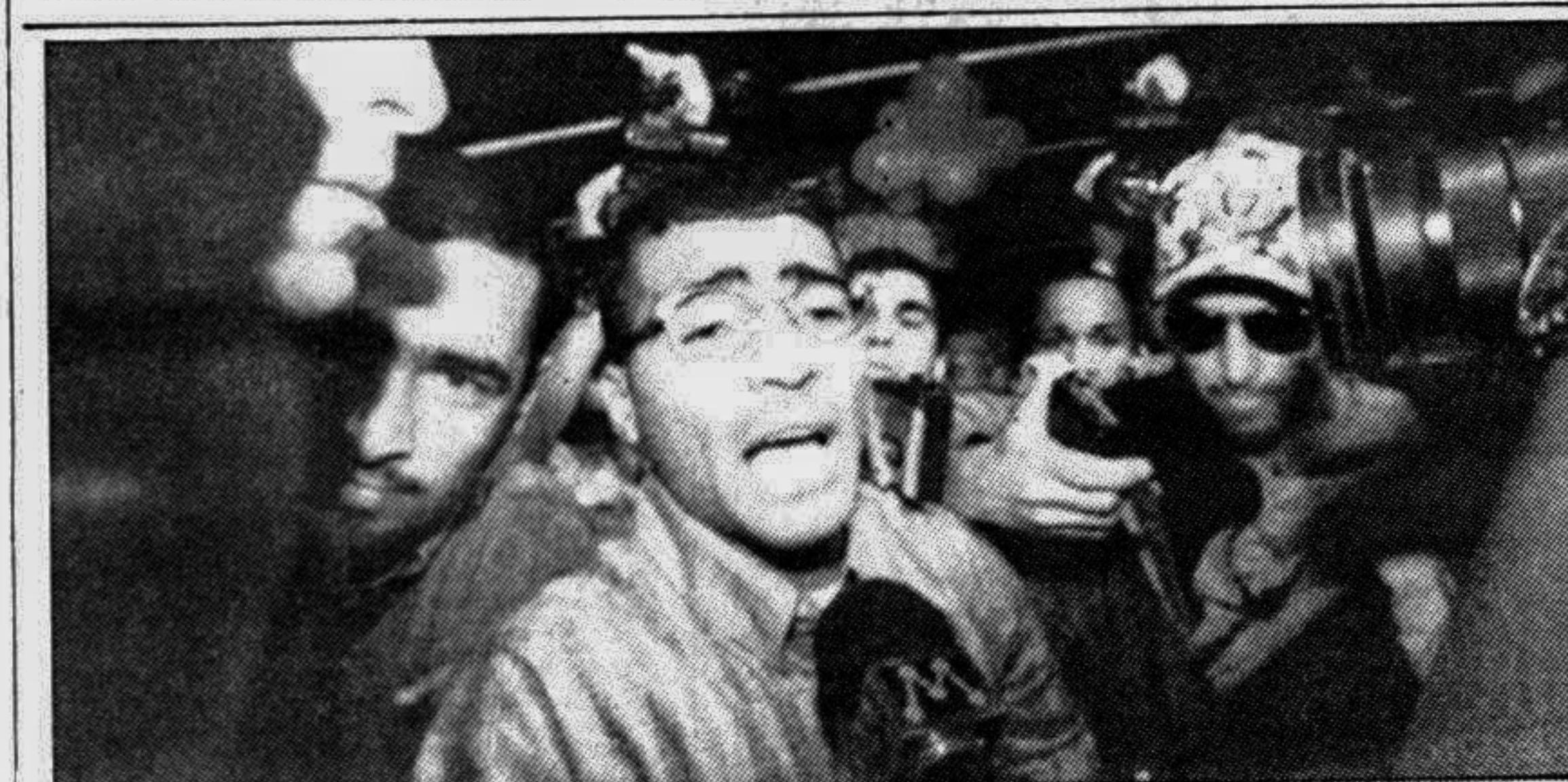
This was Davenport's sixth visit to Roland Garros and her previous best was a quarterfinal berth in 1996. But she had a

Big hearted Moroccans

In October they performed creditably in Belem against their World Cup opponents Brazil, the 2-0 defeat coming only courtesy of a late Denilson brace for the South Americans.

Less encouraging was the disappointing African Nations' Cup campaign in Burkina Faso in February which saw Morocco eliminated in the quarter finals by South Africa and lose their ranking as Africa's best team.

"Naturally, it was a disappointment but we had key players out with injury and illness and this cost us," said Michel.

Among those was Salaheddine Bassir, who has scored 15 times for his country in the last 18 months.

Bassir was fit against for the king Hassan II warm-up tournament in Casablanca last week, scoring twice in the 2-2 draw with France. "Without him our attack was not the same," Michel said.

With this in mind, Michel criss-crossed Europe in an effort to unearth new talent among the growing number of Moroccans playing in Europe and he also brought back Italian-based defender Rachid Nekrouz.

Most of his squad come from clubs in Europe, which Michel admits makes life difficult for a national team coach.

They did just that last time round when their record of three defeats out of three did not tell the whole story.

After losing 1-0 to Belgium and 2-1 to Saudi Arabia at USA 94 they gave the much-fancied Netherlands a huge fright before again losing narrowly, 2-1.

A feature of their play was their speed on the counter, and there will no doubt be more of the same in France.

They served up a timely reminder during the 2-2 draw against the World Cup hosts last week. Bassir's second goal a superb strike from the edge of the box at the end of a lightning break down the right.

Morocco possess some gifted players, particularly on the flanks where Abdellah Saber and Abdelkrim El Hadrioui are very dangerous on the overlap.

In defence, captain Noureddine Naybat will bring a wealth of experience and in midfield Mustapha Hadji is a world-class performer.

Both have played in the French league and Morocco can call upon several other players with experience of the conditions in France. The French-speaking Moroccans can also expect the backing of some 20,000 fans in France.
