DCC can dispose of only half the daily wastes

Capital Dhaka is gradually turning into a carrion-depot as half of the solid wastes generated everyday lay aside after their disposal by the City Corporation, reports UNB.

Dhaka City Corporation the authority assigned to dispose of the wastes, is only capable of collecting 50 per cent of the total 3,500 to 4,000 metric tons of solid wastes daily.

The remaining solid wastes were either dumped in low-lying areas or collected by scavengers. World Bank sources said per capita waste generation in the city per day is 0.5 kg and it includes organic content, inorganic content and paper.

A survey of the World Bank showed that 40 to 60 per cent of the wastes in the city are domestic while 5 to 20 per cent commercial.

In a research paper on city wastes, Dr NM Kazi said the industries are potential producers of dangerous wastes as lead, cadmium and mercury are being used by those.

He also informed that except ICDDR,B, none of the 500 small to large hospitals and clinics in the city has provision for safe disposal of clinical wastes.

Health Directorate sources said the present average clinical wastes generated in hospitals and clinics is 1 kg per day for per bed and extra 200 kgs a year for clinics.

Calculation showed that nearly 20 tons of hospital wastes are generated in the city and 20 per cent of them are infectious and hazardous.

Besides, 149 tanning industries in Hazaribagh are producing 18,000 litres of liquid wastes and 115 tons of solid wastes during peak hours and 75 tons during off-peak period.

Liquid wastes are mainly dumped into the river Buriganga while a part of these into nearby drains and sewers. Solid wastes are generally collected by DCC and a part by the scavengers.

Dr Kazi said that the impact may increase probability of death and diseases like fever, headache, respiratory and skin diseases, and also may affect land use and fisheries.

"It has also negative impact on ground water, surface water and eco-system", Dr Kazi said.

No change in temp

Rain or thundershowers accompanied by temporary gusty or squally wind is likely to occur at a few places over Barisal, Chittagong and Sylhet divisions and at one or two places over Dhaka, Rajshahi and Khulna divisions in the next 12 hours till 6 pm today, reports UNB.

Country's highest temperature 36.8 degree Celsius was recorded yesterday at Rajshahi and the lowest 21.3 degree Celsius at Sylhet. The sun sets today at 6:44 pm and rises tomorrow at 5:10 am.

AL programmes on historic June 7

On this day in 1966, worker Manu Mian and several others were killed in police firing during a hartal, enforced by Awami League to press for Bangabandhu's 6-point demands, in the then East Pakistan.

Awami League and its front organisations have planned elaborate programmes to mark the day.

The programmes include hoisting of national and party flags at Bangabandhu Bhaban and party central office, placing wreaths at the portrait of Bangabandhu and holding rally at Paltan Maidan.

Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina will lead the party leaders in laying wreaths at 8 am and address the rally at 3 pm.

Similar programmes will also be organised in all divisional, district and thana headquarters.

'Oust-govt campaign if long march is disrupted'

He said that government was plotting to disrupt the long march. The meeting was held at official residence of the Leader of the Opposition in the parliament and BNP chairperson Begum Khaleda Zia in the city.

The meeting discussed preparations regarding the programme and it was resolved that Oli Ahmad would stay in Chittagang from June 8 morning to June 10 evening for coordination of the activists.

Another meeting of the long march supervisory committee would be held at the same venue at 7 pm today while a meeting of politicians and professionals would also be held at 5 pm today in regard to the long march programme.
