President urged to help combat crimes against women

A 14-member delegation of Women Repression Compliant Cell called on President Shahabuddin Ahmed at Bangabandhu yesterday, reports UNB.

The delegation submitted a memorandum to the President expressing concern at the growing trend of repression on women.

Referring to the recent rape of a 6-year-old girl in a police control room, the delegation members informed the President that no action was taken against the police. They said the police cannot avoid their responsibilities and they must be punished for their offences.

The delegation also expressed concern over granting of anticipatory bail to the

criminals and said it will encourage many others to commit such crimes.

They requested the President to take necessary steps to combat such heinous crimes and instruct all concerned to enforce the law so that the culprits do not go unpunished.

President Shahabuddin gave them a patient hearing and said he is aware of the repression on women and children, and assured them of instructing the concerned authorities to see that the culprits are given exemplary punishment as per the law of the land.

Former state minister Sarwar Rahman and Jahanara Begum were also present.

Bangladesh to participate in UN Drug Summit

Government leaders from 185 countries including Bangladesh will participate in a General Assembly special session on the world drug problem, to be held in New York starting today to 10 June. Dubbed the "Drug Summit", the event is expected to be the largest multi-lateral gathering ever held on combating illegal drug trafficking and abuse, says a press release.

The Drug Summit marks a critical new juncture in the global fight against drug supply and demand. For the first time, national leaders from throughout the world will gather together to agree to the first truly global strategy to control drugs; the first international agreement on demand reduction; and the goal of substantially reducing and eventually eradicating the illicit cultivation of opium, coca and other narcotic crops in the next 10 years.

More than 30 Presidents and Prime Ministers will attend the Drug Summit.

Students demand DU exams be rescheduled

A procession was brought out on Dhaka University campus yesterday by the students of different departments demanding shifting of the schedule of masters final examinations, reports UNB.

The authorities earlier announced that the examinations under Arts and Social Science faculties will be held from August 26. But later they shifted the date to July 26 saying the earlier announcement was a printing mistake.

The fresh schedule sparked protest from the students who said that in some departments the syllabus was not yet completed. They claimed that tutorials and in-course examinations of some departments were not yet taken as well.
