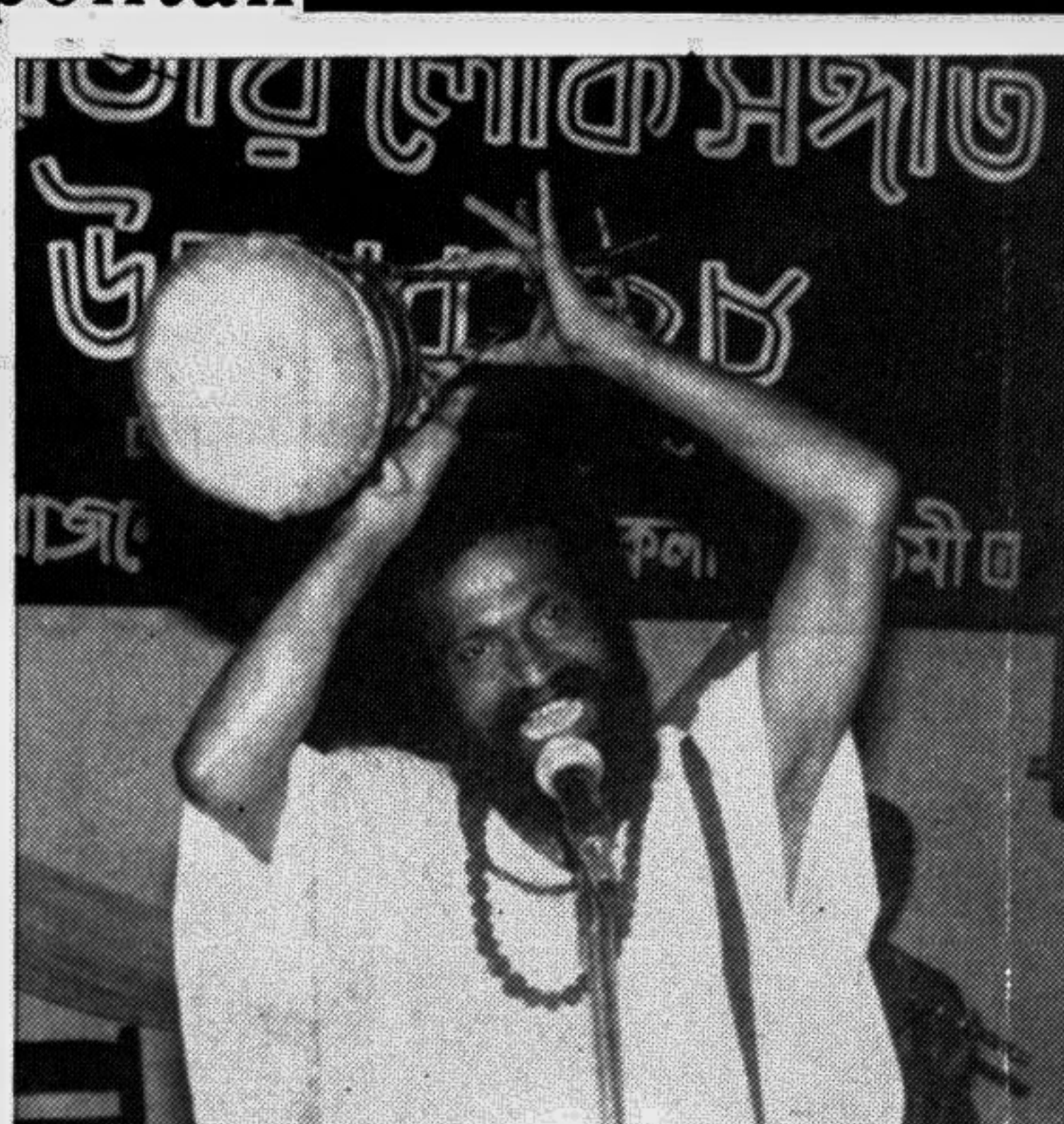

Soldiers asked to uphold image of the army
CHITTAGONG, June 10: The President's Parade marking the Commissioning of the cadets of the 38th BMA Long Course and the 17th BMA SSC special course was held at the Bangladesh Military Academy (BMA) parade ground at Bhatia yesterday, reports UNB.
Chief of Army Staff Lt General Muhammad Mustafizur Rahman reviewed the smartly turned out parade and took salute at the impressive march past.
Battalion Senior Under Officer Intekhab Haider Khan was adjudged the best all-round cadet and awarded the coveted Sword of Honour, according to an ISPR press release. He also received the Chief of Army Staff's Gold Medal for best performance in the military subjects while Cadet Muhammad Reazul Kabir got the Osmani Gold Medal for the overall best academic performance.
Meanwhile, Hamid Company received the BMA Colour for the summer term on the basis of different inter-company competitions.
Addressing the newly commissioned officers, the Chief of Army Staff said courage, discipline, honesty, sincerity, loyalty and above all patriotism were the main qualities of a military officer.
Hard training and regular exercise were the keys to success in the life of a soldier, he said.
"Boldness of personal character, professional excellence and competence were essential for an able army officer in upholding the image of the army, its honour and glorious tradition," Rahman said asking them to reflect the professional experience in their life.
He expressed his optimism that the new officers would be able to demonstrate their worth in their practical life through sincerity, initiatives, hard labour and intelligence.
High civil and military officials, diplomats, parents and relations of the cadets were also present on the occasion.
After the parade, the Chief of Army Staff visited the commandant's office.
