#### Govt to privatise all industrial units in phases, JS told

Industries Minister Tofael Ahmed yesterday informed in Parliament that a new industrial policy will be announced soon envisaging measures to match with the free-market economy, reports UNB.

He said the government will privatise all the profitable and loss-making industrial units of public sector in phases to operate in competition in the free market.

Replying to Master Mujibur Rahman (AL) during the question hour, the minister said 54 textile, jute, steel, sugar, chemical, forestry and other sectors have been identified to sell out

during the current fiscal year. The process in underway either to close down or sell the loss making public sector mills and factories.

Till December '97, he said, 11 mills of textile sector were closed down and their workers off loaded under the voluntary retirement programme by giving them all financial benefits.

The Industries minister presented a list of public sector mills and factories with year wise financial loss incurred since the nationalisation.

#### Air France reaches accord with

pilots

PARIS, June 10: Air France said Wednesday it had reached an agreement with striking pilots, ending a walkout that had severely embarrassed the country in the days leading up to the World Cup, reports AP.

In a statement, Air France said the pilots had agreed to accept company shares in exchange for salary cuts.

The company called for an immediate return to work. But the airline has said it would take three days for service to return to normal once the strike ended.

Just Tuesday night, as World Cup celebrations began in Paris, negotiations had seemed deadlocked. Pilots had gathered at Charles de Gaulle airport and agreed to continue the walkout. a despite an appeal by the transport minister to both sides to continue talking.

But in talks overnight, an agreement was reached. Jean-Cyril Spinetta othe president of Air France, told France Info radio Wednesday morning this is a compromise that is good for the company. good for the employees and good

for the clients. But he added that consequences of the strike were "heavy" and that the company had lost a billion francs (US \$166 million). Now we have to think of confidence, confidence in Air France, confidence in its

"The sentiment on the rupee is bearish. There is no intervention or any statement from the (central) reserve bank of India to support the currency," she

That realisation has prompted speculators to withdraw from the rupee.

The downward trend has delighted struggling exporters. keen to see the competitiveness of their prices improve in overseas markets.

# SEC complaints against Dowla, others

Court to decide after injunction is settled

The CMM court yesterday postponed the proceedings of the petition cases filed by the SEC against ACI company sec-retary and CCL directors due to the ad-interim order passed by the 6th Assistant Judge of Dhaka on Monday.

The postponement will con-tinue until the ad-interim order is revoked. According to sources, SEC

will soon move to vacate the injunction.

The Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) Tuesday filed two criminal cases against M Anis Ud Dowla, MD of both ACI and its sister concern CCL, ACI company secretary and four other directors of CCL on charges of fraud, insider trading and market manipulation.

The accused CCL directors are Dowla, his wife Nazma Dowla, son Arif Dowla, daughter Shusmita Salem and an ACI foundation representative Ashraf Saleheen. The accused ACI company secretary is Sheema Huq.

The petitioner said the CCL board of directors used its CEO Anis Ud Dowla for the sale of ACI shares who had access to price-sensitive information. "From the record, it appears that before the publication of information regarding the rights offer the accused company sold substantial number of its holding in ACI Ltd in the stock market."

The petitioner also said the CCL CEO and his wife Nazma Dowla were "in possession of material facts in connection with rights offer of ACI Ltd. The accused company being a beneficial owner of not less than 10 per cent of such securities in ACI Ltd and who is in possession of material facts omits to disclose any such facts while selling huge number of securities in the stock markets."

The SEC in its complaint said all these amounted to "fraudulent, deceitful and manipulative acts" under the regu-

#### US to endorse new child labour standards

WASHINGTON, Jun 10: After refusing to ratify the last international child labour convention, the United States this week will endorse proposed new global labour standards for children focusing on the most extreme abuses: prostitution, bondage and work in hazardous industries, reports AP.
