**Two cops closed**

MAGURA, Jun 10: Police Super in the district closed two police constables to the police line on Monday for their alleged involvement in a snatching case, reports UNB.  
Local people said, one Monojit, 20, while fleeing with a gold chain snatched with the help of two cops from college student Dolly Begum at Shalikhah thana was caught by them. Witnesses said he snatched the gold chain with the help of two cops Mohiuddin and Maniruzzaman of Shalikhah thana. Later the snatcher was handed over to the local police station and the public ghaored the police station in the evening demanding exemplary punishment to the two constables. Monojit was sent to Sadar thana jail hajat.

**3 killed in Ishurdi road accident**

ISHURDI, Jun 10: Three persons were killed and about 80 others injured when a passenger bus and a truck collided head-on at Dasuria (Musidpur) on Pabna-Ishurdi highway in Ishurdi thana on June 2 morning, reports BSS.  
Police said the accident occurred when a passenger bus, bound for Sirajganj from Ishurdi collided head-on with a truck. One passenger of the bus Abdur Karim (35), died on the spot while two others Abdur Aziz, 35, and Mohidul, 45, succumbed to their injuries on way to Ishurdi Hospital. About 80 passengers were injured. Twenty-two seriously injured persons were admitted to Pabna Hospital. Police seized the bus and the truck but their drivers escaped. A case has been filed with Ishurdi thana.

**26 people arrested**

JAMALPUR, Jun 10: Police rounded up 26 people including 19 absconding accused in separate drives in the district in the last fortnight, reports UNB.  
They were arrested on charges of murder, kidnapping, dacoity, theft and other criminal activities. Police in a special drive arrested seven thieves and recovered a cow and a buffalo from their possession. In another drive police also recovered a kidnapped school girl of Char Sapmari village in sadar thana and arrested the kidnapper.

**Mango pickle factory at C' nawabganj demanded**

CHAPAINAWABGANJ, June 10 : Chapainawabganj has a wide reputation for quality mango. But for the last several years the production has been decreasing remarkably due to lack of proper management and care, continuous attack of various diseases and want of scientific and technical facilities.

Of the total production of mangoes of the country more than 60 per cent are produced in Chapainawabganj alone. Not only that, the fame of Chapainawabganj mango in respect of its delicacy has spread out from Asia to Europe. Before the Liberation War of Bangladesh Bangladesh mango was in the fourth position in the world in respect of high quantity of production of mango. In the decade of 70 the average production of mango in Bangladesh was 5 lakh tons, but in the decade of 80 it came down to the quantity of 2 lakh 80 thousand tons in which 1 lakh 60 thousand tons were produced in Chapainawabganj. No other district in Bangladesh except Chapainawabganj is able to produce such a large quantity of mango. But during the subsequent years this production began to decrease. According to the office source of the Deputy Director of the Agriculture Extension Department, Chapainawabganj, in 1989 the production of mango in Chapainawabganj was 83 thousand tons, in 1990 it was only 12 thousand tons, in 1991 it was 73 thousand 1 hundred 10 tons, in 1992 it was 45 thousand 1 hundred 43 tons, in 1993 it was 1 lakh 6 hundred 36 tons, in 1994 it was 25 thousand 6 hundred 35 tons, in 1995 it was 1 lakh 20 thousand tons, in 1996 it was 14 thousand 4 hundred 45 tons, in 1997 it was 91 thousand 9 hundred 64 tons. From the data of production given above it has been proved that the production of mango faces a set-back in every alternative year and this norm is a violent blow to the prospect of mango. Of course a few variety named 'Mahananda' and another variety from India 'Amrapali' are able to yield fruits every year.

Although the production per acre has been remaining almost constant for the last two decades the area of mango gardens has been increasing every year. In 1991 mango gardens in Chapainawabganj covered an area of 16 thousand 7 hundred 83 acres, in 1992 it was 17 thousand 3 hundred 6 acres, in 1993 it was 18 thousand 656 acres, in 1995 it was 19 thousand 760 acres, in 1996 it was 19 thousand 940 acres and in 1997 the area of mango gardens came upto 20 thousand 235 acres.

This year is an off year for mangoes. Besides, cold wave and heavy fog affected budding in due time. As a result, the size of mango has become smaller. Yet 25 per cent of the normal production was expected this year. But during riping period a new type of pest-attack has made the farmers completely disappointed. This type of pest-attack is found in almost all the gardens of the district. According to the garden owners, one kind of insect bores the lower part of a mango and destroys it. It is widely found in the mango gardens.

Mango is such a fruit which can be used at its every stage. If proper measure is taken up by the government, not a single mango would be perished unused. Mango-pickle has a great demand both inside the country and abroad for its delicacy. Thousands of tons of mangoes perish every year during natural calamities.

A mango-pickle factory is a long cherished demand of the people of the area. Mangoes which fall from trees during cyclone can be collected and utilised. Mango-pickle can be exported abroad and government can earn a lot of foreign exchange.
