WFP food aid for Rohingya refugees

The Regional Director of the Asia-Pacific Bureau of the World Food Programme (WFP) Rome, has approved a concluding phase of the relief operation to provide food aid to Rohingya refugees in Bangladesh, says a press release.

During the period of this extension, WFP will supply 2,965 mt of food commodities to some 21,000 refugees.

The cost of the project to WFP will be around USD 1,263,000. The total cost of the project will be USD 3,341,000 including the contribution from UNRWA.

The food basket provided by WFP covers basic nutritional requirements and is composed of commodities familiar to the refugees (rice, pulses, oil, salt, sugar and blended food).

Supplementary and therapeutic feeding is provided to vulnerable groups, particularly children suffering from acute malnutrition, pregnant and nursing mothers and medical cases with chronic diseases. Food commodities are locally or internationally purchased.

One sustains acid-burn injuries

A garments worker sustained severe acid-burn injuries when a youth threw acid on her in the city yesterday, reports UNB.

Police said one Ratan threw acid on Rita, 18, daughter of Jalal Sikder of village Mollar Dalg, Sadarpur thana, Faridpur district, near the rail-crossing of Baro Maghbazar at noon.

Rita was returning to her Outer Circular road residence from her work place.

According to police Rita got married to one Jahangir Alam about a year ago, refusing Ratan's proposal. Ratan was working at a motor workshop at Maghbazar at the time.

Rita was rushed to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital and a case filed with Ramna police in this connection.

Workshop on LGED project

Participants at a start-up workshop on 'Third Rural Infrastructure Development Project' of LGED unanimously held the view that any technology had to be designed on technical and economic criteria, but also had to be adjusted to the economic and socio-political environment in which it would be used, says a press release.

The speakers also stressed the need to develop the capacity of local government bodies at union level, to manage local level structure and to introduce a more participatory approach.

The workshop was organised by LGED in the city yesterday. It was chaired by Q I Siddique, Chief Engineer, LGED. The inaugural session was addressed by Mujibur Rahman, Dr Aard Hartveld and Youssef Attiq of IFAD, John Brooks of Asian Development Bank, and OECF (Japan) representative Tsumuro Sudo. Project Director Wahidur Rahman gave the welcome address.

Q I Siddique said that in infrastructure development participatory approach was the flagship of LGED. He said that the Third Rural Infrastructure Development Project, with estimated cost of 181 million US dollar, would be implemented in four greater districts of Dinajpur, Rangpur, Jamalpur and Mymensingh covering an area of about 30,000 sq km.

The overall objective of the project is to accelerate agricultural, non-farm, economic and social development in the project areas by improving basic rural transport and supporting infrastructure in a sustainable manner with beneficiaries participation in all stages of project implementation.

Executive engineers and thana engineers of the project districts participated in the workshop.

BAU admission tests today

The tests will be based on multiple choice questions (MCQ).

Some 6450 students will vie for 663 seats in six faculties this year.

Rafiqul Islam Mia sues 'Sangbad'

The First Sub Judge Court, Dhaka yesterday issued summons against the Editor, editor-in-charge and news editor of the daily 'Sangbad' upon a suit for damage and compensation filed by former Public Works Minister Rafiqul Islam Mia, Bar-at-Law.

In his complaint, Rafiqul Islam said he was hurt by a report published in the said daily on May 27, as it brought allegation against him of acquiring a RAJUK plot illegally during his tenure as minister.

Explaining the reason to file the damage suit of Tk 50 crore, Rafiq claimed that the newspaper failed to publish a rejoinder which he had sent after publication of the news item.

BLAST serves legal notice on PSC chairman

Bangladesh Legal Aid and Services Trust (BLAST) has served a legal notice on the Chairman of Public Service Commission (PSC) for publishing an advertisement in a national daily on May 30 inviting applications for 1185 posts of Bangladesh Civil Services (BCS) through the 20th BCS examination of 1998-99, says a press release.

The notice was served as the condition 4 (b) of the PSC advertisement was 'discriminatory' and 'violative' of Article 27 of the Constitution of Bangladesh.

The condition bars candidates from applying for the examination those who have married 'non-Bangladeshi' citizens or have promised to marry 'non-Bangladeshi' citizens despite having all other required qualifications.

The notice pointed out that the advertisement was also against 'Article 31' of the Constitution.

The notice further pointed out that the imposed condition was not relevant to the job to be applied for and not applicable to the candidate himself or herself and was beyond the scope of the recruitment process.

BCU gheraoes DU VC office, submits memorandum

Bangladesh Chhatra Union (BCU) yesterday gheraoed the office of the Vice Chancellor of the Dhaka University demanding withdrawal of the decision to increase the tuition fees and other charges of the university.

The BCU also demanded increase in the number and amount of scholarships.

The university authorities recently decided to raise the tuition fee and other charges from the coming session.

BCU organised a rally in front of the VC office. DU unit president Sharifuzaman Sharif, general secretary Kollan Kollol and another leader Biplob Thakur addressed the rally.

The BCU later submitted a memorandum to the VC. The VC assured the BCU leaders that he would consider their demands.

Trust fund after Tofazzal Hosen set up at DU

A new trust fund named after Tofazzal Hosen (Manik Mia) has been set up at the Dhaka University, reports BSS.

Chairman of Manik Mia Foundation Barrister Mainul Hosen donated a cheque for Taka five lakh to the Vice-Chancellor of DU, Prof A K Azad Chowdhury, at a simple ceremony held at the VC's office yesterday.

The ceremony was attended, among others, by senior journalist Rokunuzzaman Khan Dada Bhai, Pro-Vice Chancellor of DU Prof Shahid Uddin Ahmed, DU treasurer Prof M Shamsul Haque, Dean of Arts Faculty Prof Kazi Shahidullah, Chairman of the Mass Communication and Journalism Department Dr Sitara Parvin and Registrar of DU Muhammad Selim.

Out of the income of the trust fund, a student obtaining highest marks in Masters final examinations among all the departments under arts, social sciences and business studies faculties of the university will be awarded a gold-medal and Tk 10,000 in cash every year.

Besides, a student of the journalism department who obtains the highest marks in the first year final examinations will be given Tk 1,000 per month as scholarship to complete the rest of the three-year honours course.
