20 hurt as armed men attack Dacca Dyeing Factory

A gang of more than 100 armed men stormed into a factory of Dacca Dyeing & Manufacturing Company Ltd at Tongi, leaving at least 20 workers injured Thursday morning.

Company officials said the attackers assaulted the factory staff, looted a large quantity of fabrics, and finished goods. They also damaged almost all the machinery and other equipment in the factory during the attack which continued for about one and half hours.

The gang members were equipped with firearms, sharp weapons, iron rods and sticks. The officials said the gang made the attack at about 10 am and fired at least 10 gun shots. Bullet-hit Zulfiqar, 55, and Bashir Ahmed, 30, were rushed to the Dhaka medical college hospital, they said.

The reason behind the attack could not be known immediately.

Mannan Bhuiyan condemns attack

BNP leader Abdul Mannan Bhuiyan yesterday condemned the attack on Dhaka Dyeing Mills by what he called government-patronised terrorists, report UNB.

In a statement, the BNP Secretary General said the ruling party terrorists attacked and damaged the mills, owned by BNP MP Salauddin Kader Chowdhury, for refusing to give extortion money.

He said the terrorists not only damaged machinery of the mills, but also took away fabrics and other valuables worth about Tk one crore.

Police was informed, but for reasons unknown they reached there late, he said.

29 injured in bus-truck collision

Thirty people, including a foreigner, were injured in two separate road accidents in Mymensingh yesterday, reports UNB.

Of the injured, eight were admitted to the Mymensingh Medical College Hospital in critical condition.

Police sources said a Dhaka-bound bus from Mymensingh collided with a truck coming from opposite direction at Mashkanda on the Dhaka-Mymensingh Highway at 6:30 am leaving 29 people injured.

Of them, Abdul Hye 40, Joyal Abedin, 40, Mannan 22, Shamsul Huq, 30, Hira, 19, Jalli, 60 and Alamgir 25 were admitted to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital. Rest of the injured were released after first-aid.

Police seized both the vehicles.

In another accident Allan, 41, an American Engineer working with an NGO, received injuries when his motorcycle was hit by a speeding bus coming from opposite direction at the Muktagachha new bazar crossing at 10 am.

He was first taken to Muktagachha Health Complex but later shifted to Mymensingh Medical College Hospital following deterioration of his condition.

Police seized the bus and arrested its driver.
