Upgradation of Kotiadi Health Complex demanded

KISHOREGANJ, Jun 12: The Thana Health Complex at Kotiadi here is beset with many problems causing untold sufferings to the patients, reports UNB. Local people have urged the authorities to take immediate steps to mitigate the problems faced by the thana health complex and demanded to upgrade it to a 100-bed one. The ambulance of the hospital is out of order for the last 15 months. The authorities said the repair work could not be done as they are yet to obtain the permission of Bangladesh Road Transport Authority (BRTA) though they applied three times for it. The vehicle is now lying under the open sky. The X-ray machine remained unused as there is no radiologist in the health complex. Presently, there is no X-ray plate in the hospital and the technician is getting his salary virtually without any work. There is allegation that he does not attend the office regularly.

The post of pathologist remains vacant hampering the tests at the pathological laboratory. There is an operation theatre in the hospital, but without necessary equipment. Treatment of diarrhoea patients is being hampered seriously due to want of IV saline in the hospital stock. There are reports of the spread of diarrhoea in different villages, but there is no arrangement of separate ward for the treatment of patients. The service at the hospital's emergency section is not up to the mark, alleged local people adding that the section should be shifted to the front side of the hospital instead of keeping it in the back. It is essential to assign a full time Emergency Medical Officer for the emergency section. The service here should be improved in order to reduce the sufferings of the patients, said local people. Floor, bathrooms, bed sheets of the patients remain dirty most of the time complained the hospital inmates. Essential life saving drugs and other materials including gauge and bandage are short in supply and the patients themselves often need to supply necessary drugs from outside. The hospital is running with scarcity of water for long. The standard of food supplied in the hospital is very low, complained the patients. There is also allegations of irregular presence of doctors in the hospital. They reportedly engage themselves in private practice even in the duty hours.

Application of modern tech will help increase mango output

KUSHTIA, Jun 12: Mango, one of the main seasonal and favourite fruits of our country is now very expensive due to gradual fall in production, reports UNB. The price of different varieties of mangoes available in the local markets are more than double in comparison with those of previous years. The prices of mangoes have shot up this year due to sharp fall in production and rising demand in home and abroad. Huge quantity of mangoes are produced including the quality ones in Greater Kushtia district. But the production has fallen by 50 per cent during the last 15 years for want of pragmatic policy and patronisation. A large number of mango trees are destroyed every year for use as fuel. The bulk use of these trees in brickfields and tobacco re-drying factories has aggravated the situation.

Finding no other alternative, poverty-stricken people of villages sell trees to earn their livelihood. It is learnt that the production in other main mango producing areas like Greater Rajshahi, Dinajpur and Rangpur districts has also fallen abnormally. According to reports, the total mango production in our country was three lakh tons in 1985 and it came down to 1.80 lakh tons in 1991. A total of 45,000 hectares of land are now under mango cultivation. The production per hectare is now four tons which was 6.60 tons in 1995. Quality mangoes are produced in the northern zone of the country including Greater Kushtia district. Quality mangoes are known as Langra, Khirsapat, Hunsagar, Bombai, Fazli and Dudhsagar.

About 5,000 people are engaged in mango production in Greater Kushtia while in Rajshahi, Rangpur and Dinajpur more than 50,000 people are engaged in mango production. Numerous traders and brokers from different parts of the country including Dhaka, Chittagong, Khulna and Narayanganj gather to the aforementioned districts to buy mangoes. Bangladeshi mangoes have also high demand abroad. In the seventies, Bangladesh was the fourth biggest mango producing country of the world but now its position is 10th, it is learnt. According to experts, Bangladesh can regain the previous position by boosting production through application of modern technology which will fetch a lot of foreign exchange besides meeting the local demand.

Storm lashes 3 thanas of Rangpur

RANGPUR, Jun 12: A severe storm that lashed the Sadar, Gangachhara and Pirgachha thana on Saturday night killed a minor girl, injured 20 people and damaged crops and dwellings extensively, reports UNB. The minor girl, Bithi, 3, of Tajhat village in sadar thana was killed when a tree fell on her. The injured people were admitted to different thana health complexes and Rangpur Medical College Hospital. Witnesses said the storm accompanied by heavy rains damaged about 2,000 dwelling houses and a number of educational institutions and crops on a vast tract of land in the three thanas.

People of Kumira exposed to risk of arsenic contamination

SATKHIRA, Jun 12: A large number of tubewells have been sealed off at Kumira union in Tala thana due to presence of arsenic in water of those tubewells. Besides, 300 tubewells in the entire thana have been put on red alert, apprehending the danger of arsenic contamination. According to a survey conducted from March 9 to 14 under the joint auspices of United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and Dhaka Community Hospital, it has been revealed, people of Kumira union parishad are exposed to the risk of arsenic contamination. When contacted Dr Tuhin, a member of the survey team told this correspondent that at least 40 persons had been affected by arsenic related disease. Of them condition of Nahar Begum and her son Mohammad Ali, Shudharon Bose, Babulal Bose and Tofazzel Hossain has been deteriorating. The survey report further revealed, the whole union is in great panic. Installation of deep tubewells on emergency basis, will redress sufferings of people in the union, the survey team suggested.
