Repression on women and children Capital punishment for culprits sought

Speakers at a discussion yesterday said that culprits responsible for violence on women and children should be given capital punishment to put an end to the repressions. Expressing dissatisfaction over the fact rapists are being freed rather than being punished, they underscored the need for outright resistance from all quarters of society to curb all kinds of human rights violations. Suggesting reform of the existing laws on women and child repression, they said laws should be enacted with such provisions that the rapists would have to prove themselves innocent.

The discussion on "Rape and Murder of Women and Children: Remedies and Protection" was held at the WVA auditorium in the city yesterday. Jointly organised by Platform to Resist Violence Against Women (PRVAW) in collaboration with Study and Research Group, the discussion was participated by representatives from 41 women rights organisations from across the country.

Presided by PRVAW president Hasna J Moudud, it was attended by Justice Abdur Rouf, Appellate Division, Bangladesh Supreme Court, as chief guest.

Mahila Parishad leader Maleka Begum, Study and Research Group President Firoze M Hasan, Supreme Court Bar Association president Habibul Islam Bhuiyan, advocate Salma Ali, barrister Tania Amir, Prof Nazma Siddique, Munira Khan and theatre activist Mahbuba Haq, among others, took part in the discussion.

Justice Abdur Rouf called for launching a movement immediately to root out the problem of women and child repression from society. He also said the media could play a vital role in checking violence against women and children by creating public awareness.

He proposed making population registration mandatory and underscored the need for a multipurpose ID card.

Jahanara Haq said the time has come to raise voice against 'marital rape'. She also called for creating public awareness and enforcement of laws to check violence against women and children.

Maleka Begum said that not only the women, but also the entire society is being affected due to the repression on women and children.

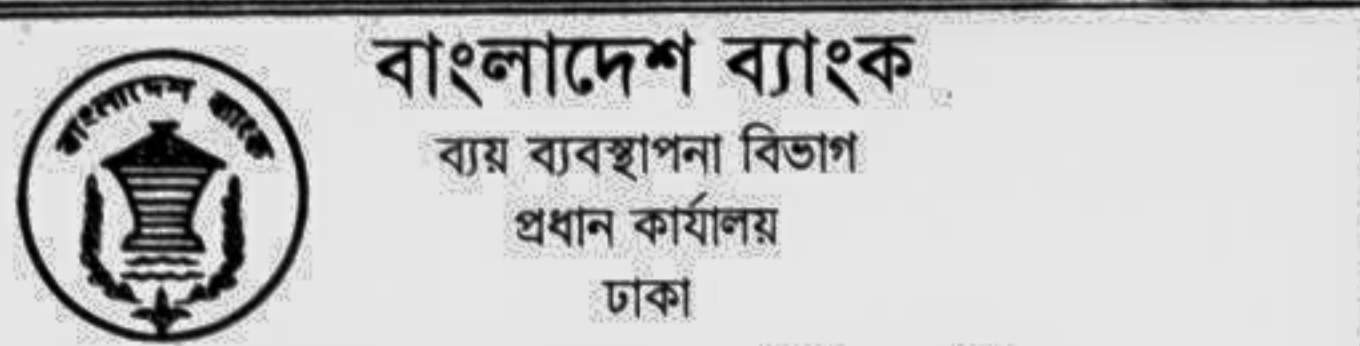
"All of us should come forward to play individual role in this regard rather than blaming the government," she said.

She also urged the lawyers not to plead for rapists before the court.

Advocate Salma Ali said existing laws are not sufficient to check violence against women and children. She said that the government should seek opinions from women's organisations before passing the proposed Women and Child Repression Act 1998.

She alleged that women were being violated in thana safe custodies by police.

Advocate Habibur Islam Bhuiyan stressed on creating social consciousness and urged the government to appoint more judges considering our huge population.
